so keep up your chin.

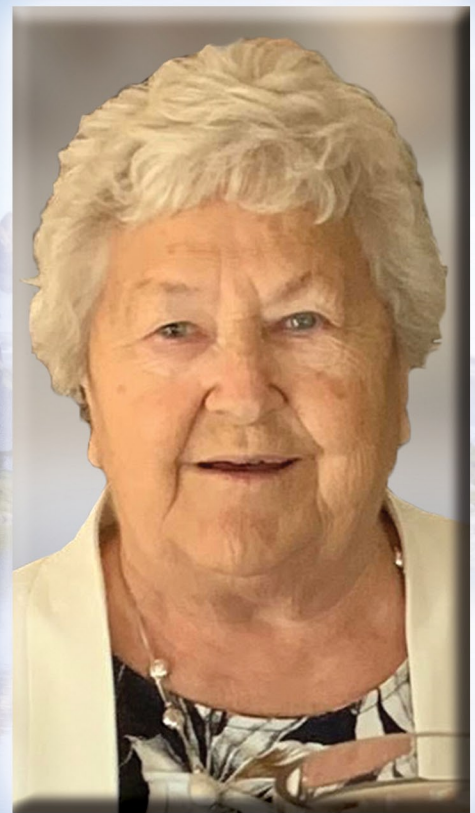
