Rose is survived by her children, Ralph (Christine) Workman of Calgary, Vicky Lee Monette of Grande Prairie, Chuck (Brenda) Workman of Calgary, Joe Workman of Lethbridge and Donna Reid of Nova Scotia, as well as six grandchildren, four great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild. They moved to Coaldale where they bought a home. She started cooking at the Coaldale Motor Inn. Later, she became a business owner at DJ Cab Company. She retired and moved to Lethbridge. She then started taking up her hobbies: painting, making flower, arrangements, and Christmas decorations.

She became born again around 1979 and was baptized at the home of Dr. George and Dr. Hazel Hills in their swimming pool. She was a long-time member of Victory Church.
