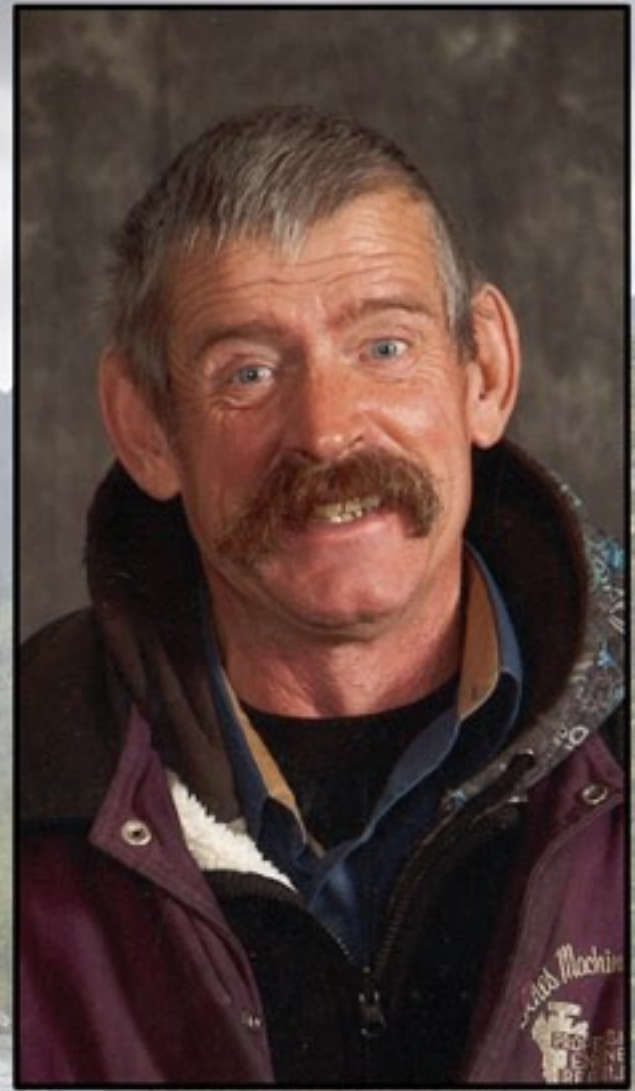


Isaiah 40:29-31
