


*The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Darryl Lloyd Nickel, age 73, of Lethbridge passed away Monday, March 2, 2020 at the St. Michael's Health Centre.

Darryl was born September 19, 1946 to Lloyd and Clara Nickel, in Herbert, SK. He began grade one at Vickers School. (A single-room school) and later attended schools in Hodgeville, SK. After graduating grade 12 he moved to Calgary, AB to complete the Farm Mechanics program at SAIT. In 1967 he then returned to the family farm.

Darryl married Diana McIntosh, on April 13, 1974. Together, they raised their three children, Jeff, Tyler and Dayne. After farming for many years, Darryl and Diana decided to move their family to Lethbridge, AB in the summer of 1991. He worked as a mechanic at the Lethbridge Country Club for 22 years before retiring in 2012 due to his Parkinson's disease.

In April 2017, his condition progressed enough that he needed more care and was moved to St. Michael's Health Centre where he resided until his passing.

Darryl enjoyed baseball, football and hockey. He was a fan of the New York Yankees and the Dallas Cowboys. He spent many years as an umpire for softball as well as several seasons assisting on the bench for his kid's hockey teams. He looked forward to the visits from his grandchildren who could always brighten his day. He was a gentle soul, who will be greatly missed by all who knew him.
