In recent months, he was most excited to have finished building a customized workshop in his backyard in Picture Butte, with the help of long-time family friend Mark, which would have been a perfect space for bringing his many hobbies and ideas to life. Casey passed away on December 13th, 2021 in Lethbridge, in the presence of family and loved ones. He is predeceased by his "Irish twin" sister Heather, father Lorne, and large family of beloved Siberian huskies.

He is survived by his mother Carolyn, eldest siblings Robert and Janeal, niece Erin, and much adored dogs Saphie and Gibson.
