April 6, 1958 — January 16, 2023

**DALE KENTON SOROCHAN**, of Lethbridge, passed away suddenly at the Chinook Regional Hospital on Monday, January 16, 2023 at the age of 64 years.

Dale is survived by his siblings: Glenn (Heather) Sorochan of Campbell River, Don (Dilene) Sorochan of Lethbridge, Myra Sorochan of Lethbridge, Jannette Sorochan of Lethbridge and James Sorochan of Lethbridge. Dale was diagnosed with schizophrenia in his early twenties, which limited his involvement in the business, but he still managed to work off and on until his late twenties. Dale was proud of his involvement with Lethbridge Jaycees, Canadian Mental Health and his church.

Dale continued to struggle with his mental health and more recently, his physical health.
