

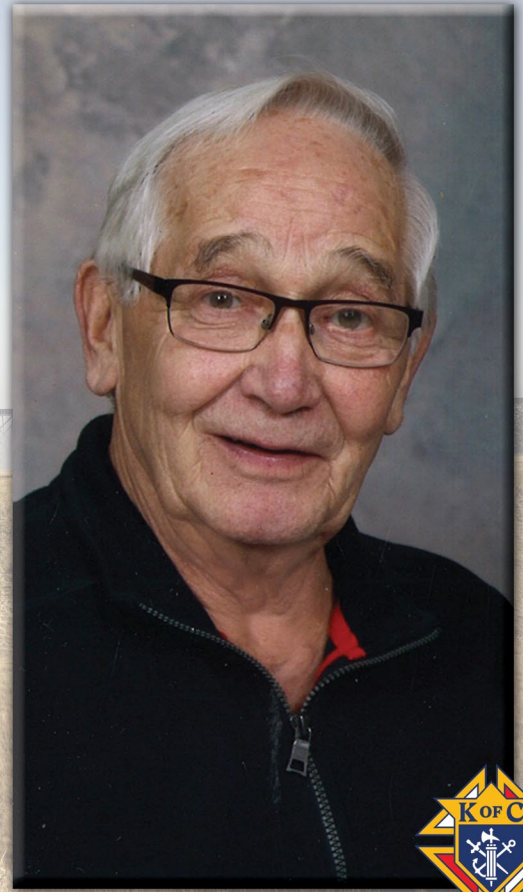


WEEP NOT FOR ME
