AND IT IS IN DYING THAT WE ARE BORN TO ETERNAL LIFE.

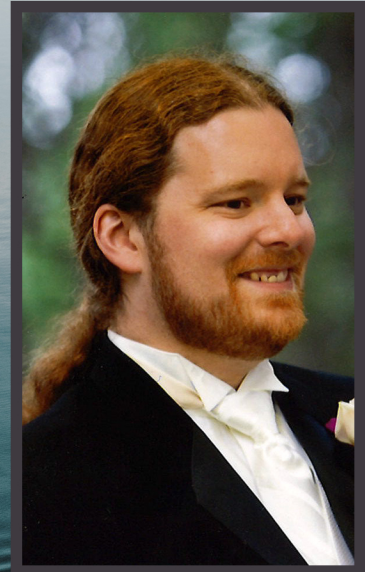
