Throughout her lifetime, Barbara was a hard worker; she was a gifted cook and seamstress and made beautiful quilts and crafts which she supplemented her income. She was also a dedicated employee at Blood Tribe Health Department for many years until she retired.

Barbara loved her large extended family and her many, many friends. As a friend, ‘she loved a good time, she had your back and told you like it was’. She will be best remembered for her good humour, her good stories and her generous spirit.
