Lovingly Remembered

Bo Hing Luk

August 30, 1925 - October 31, 2019

Bo Hing Luk was born on August 30, 1925 in Taiping, Malaysia and later moved to China and Guangzhou. In 1945, she married Sung Mun Yeen where they started a new life together, and where she began to follow Christianity. Four years later in 1949, they had a beautiful daughter named Sung Yuk Ha. The family traveled between Guangzhou and Hong Kong over the years until in 1973 when Yuk Ha moved to Canada and married Lee Kok Leung. In 1975, Bo Hing moved to Canada to be with her daughter and son-in-law as they were expecting their first child, Andrew, nine months later.

Somewhere along the way between Malaysia and Canada, there were errors made that she became two years younger than her original birthdate, hence 1927 versus 1925. She was quite surprised and happy for the compliment after learning about this error.

Throughout Bo Hing's life, she believed in God and spent her Sunday mornings going to church. Over time, she felt tired and weak, and became less involved with the church and more concentrating on her health. She never gave up on God as she knows God will always be there for whoever believes in Him. She continues to read her Chinese Bible at home and that God will always be in her heart.

In her leisure time, her favourite pastime is playing mah-jong. Win or lose, she likes the game as it offers opportunity for her to socialize with people and helps her keep her mind sharp. If she's not playing mah-jong, she likes to make clothes by hand for herself and for her grandson. Every year, she would sew and knit a new set of clothes.

Everybody is a fan of good food. Bo Hing likes her food simple and the old fashioned way. Her biggest appetite dish is salty fish and rice with a side of choy sum. When she has time, she likes to make her favourite foods like fried yam dough, and nian gao rice cakes.

She is survived by her daughter Yuk Ha, son-in-law Kok Leung, grandson Andrew, and great granddaughter Khloe.
