Could I have one doubt or dread?*

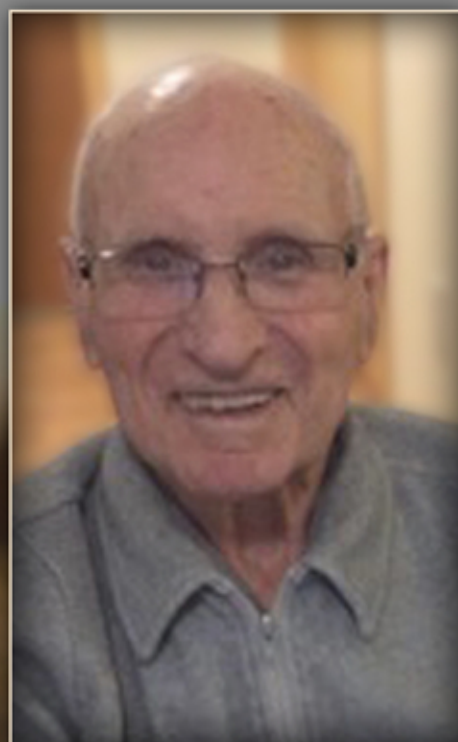
*Then you must not grieve so sorely,
