Don't worry about falls.

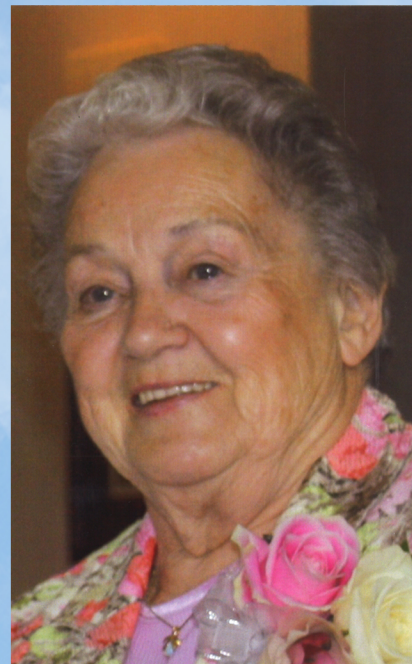
I miss you all so dearly,

## Forever Remembered

MARGARET "FLORENCE" PANSKY (nee ALEXANDER) passed away peacefully, at St. Michael's Health Centre in Lethbridge on July 30, 2021, at the age of 91 years surrounded by her children.

Florence was born in Fort Macleod, Alberta, on April 30, 1930, and grew up on the family farm in the Hazelmere district south of Fort Macleod. She attended Hazelmere School and completed her high school in Fort Macleod. Then Florence worked at the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce in Fort Macleod.
