put the tractor in the shed.

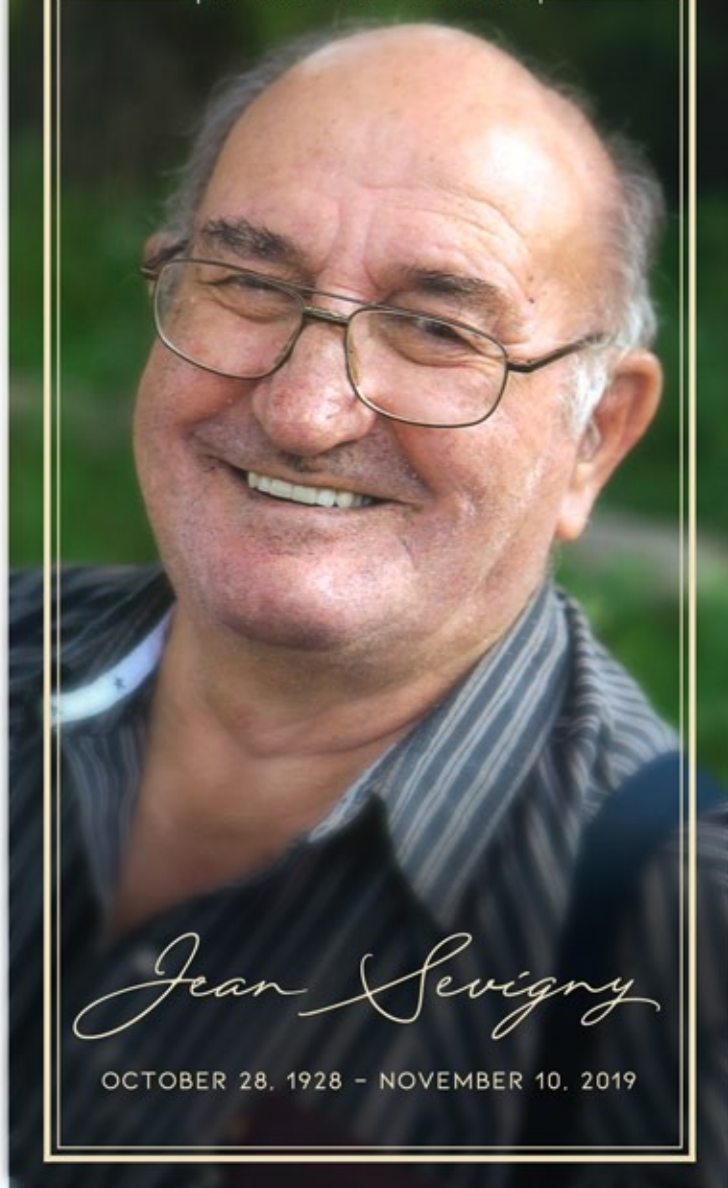
Years were not easy, many downright hard,
