Or just a soft embrace.

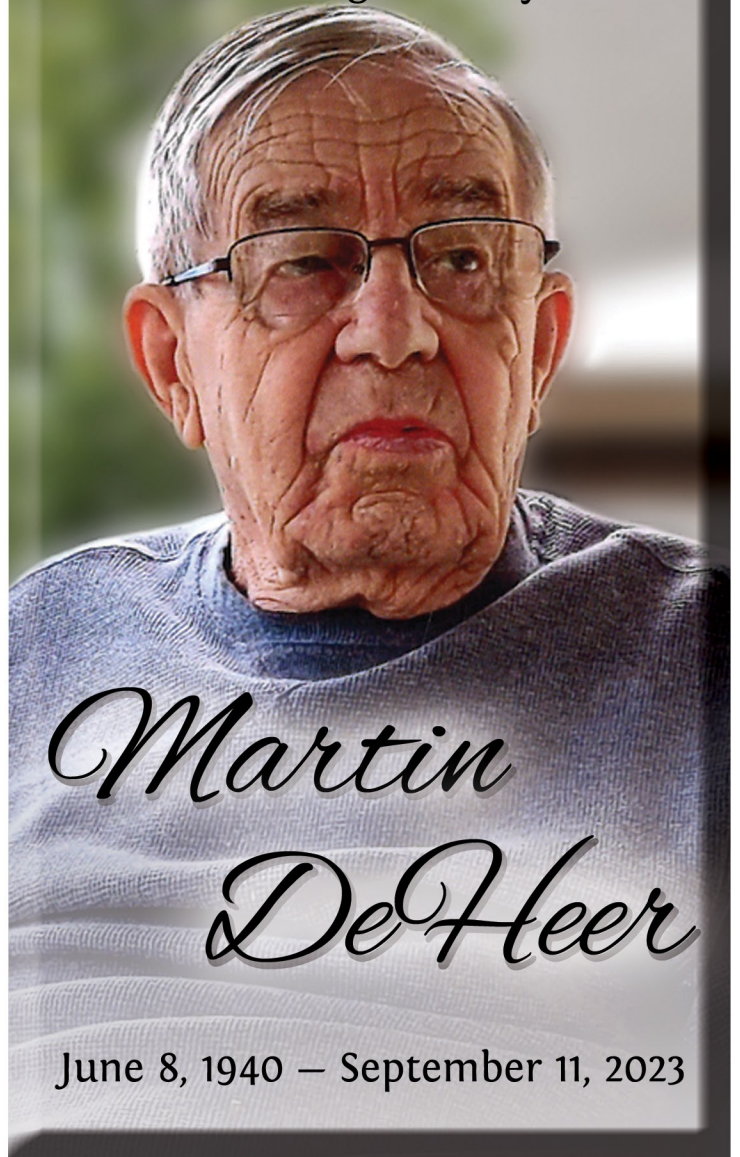
SO please don't be unhappy,
