Peace on earth we will see.

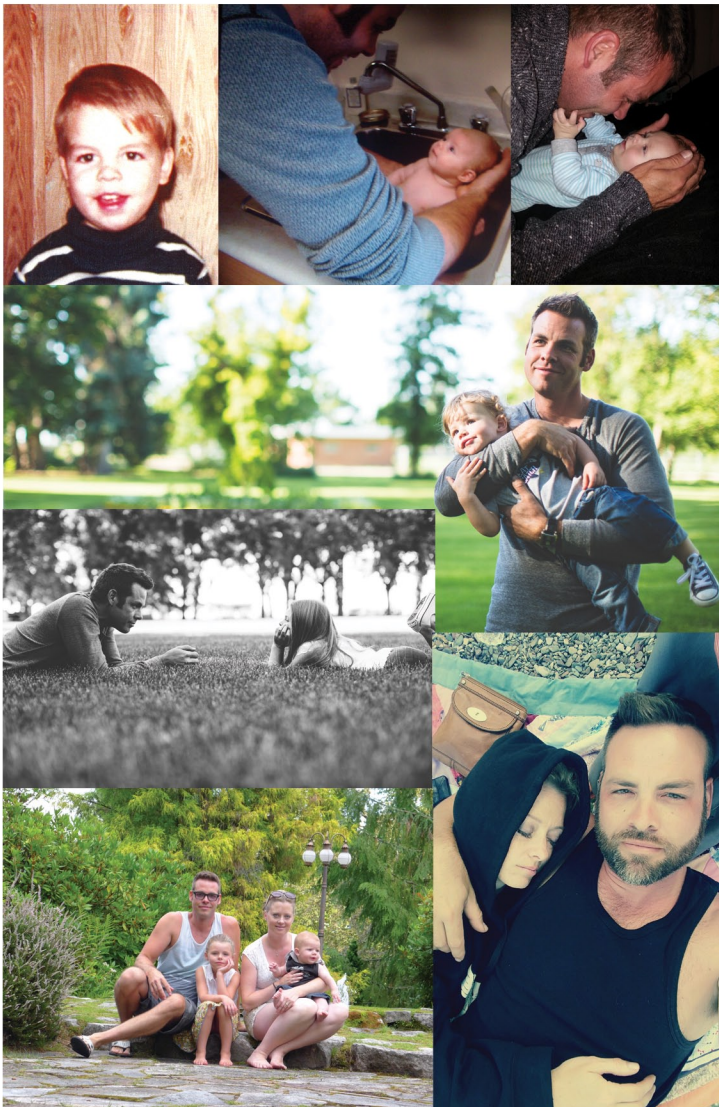
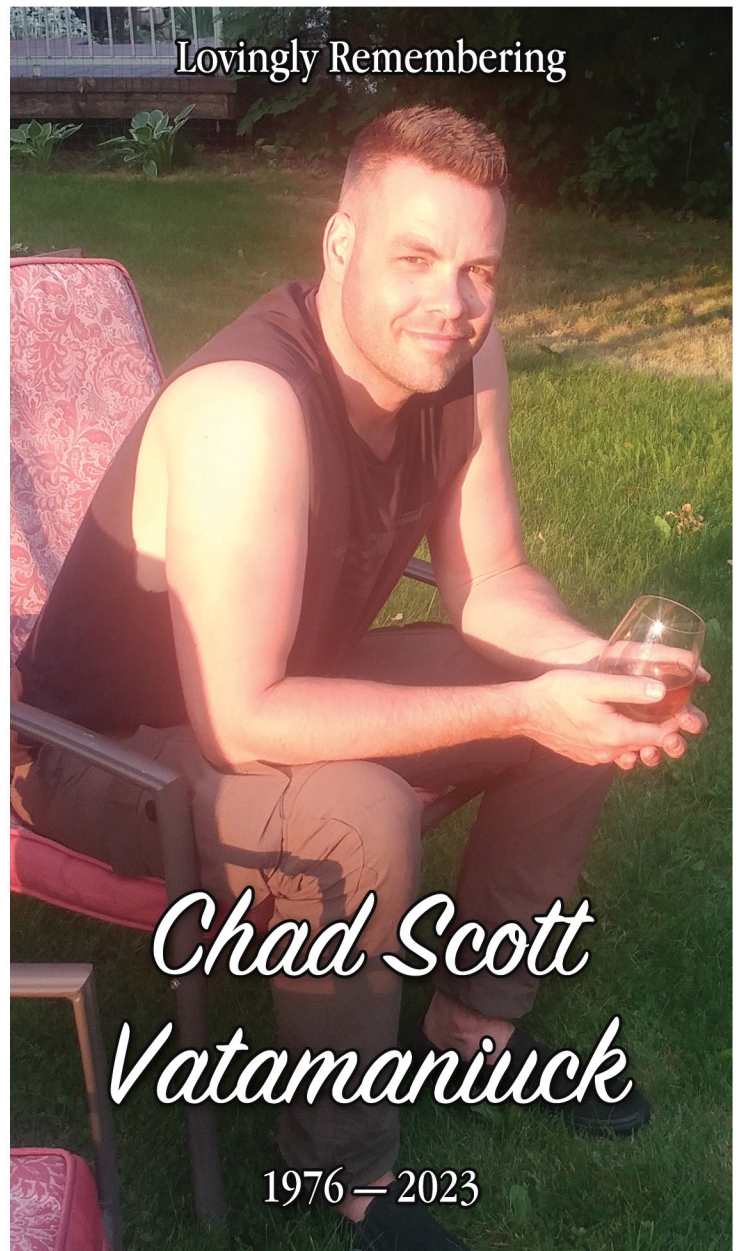
