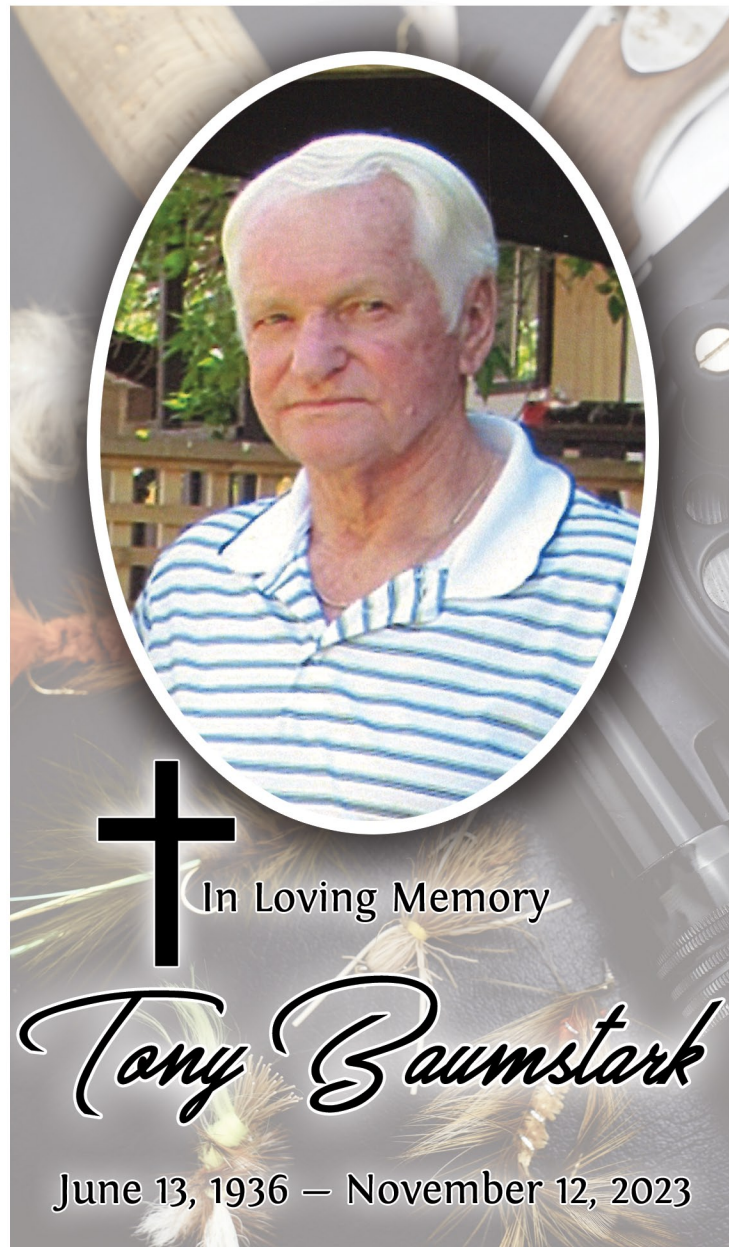

ANTON "TONY" BAUMSTARK of Magrath, AB, beloved husband Wilma Baumstark for 62 years, passed away at the Foothills Hospital in Calgary, AB on Sunday, November 12, 2023 at the age of 87 years.

Along with his wife, he is lovingly remembered by their daughter, Jeannette Lindley, grandchildren, Cayla and Cory Lindley, Nicole Tulloch and great-grandchild, Sophie Tulloch.

Tony was predeceased by his daughter, Debbie, brothers-in-law, Rudy Gregus and Fred Holzworth, and sister-in law Darlene Holzworth.

Tony was born June 13, 1936 to Jacob and Veronika Baumstark, a farming family of Malcoci, Romania. During the war in 1941, the Baumstark family was moved to Germany then to Poland and in 1944, back to Germany.

In 1953, the Baumstark family immigrated to Canada (Iron Springs, AB) where they worked in the sugar beet industry. In 1955, the family moved to Taber, AB to work and help raise cattle on the Broder farm. Eventually, Tony started working at Water Resources in Enchant.

Tony's passion was soccer and he played for many years for the Lethbridge Bombers. It was there he met Wilma, and they were married in Lethbridge on July 21, 1961.

Tony and Wilma moved to Edmonton where his oldest daughter attended the School for the Deaf, and they remained in Edmonton until their retirement.

In 2015 they moved to Magrath to be closer to family. Tony spent many happy days camping, fishing, and spending time with his children, grandchildren, and great granddaughter.
