ACAPS – Assessment Capacities Initiative

ACAPS is an independent information provider and specialist in humanitarian needs analysis and assessment. It enables crisis responders to better understand and thereby better address the world's disasters.

Crisis Group

The International Crisis Group is an independent organisation working to prevent wars and shape policies that will build a more peaceful world. Crisis Group sounds the alarm to prevent deadly conflict.

FEWS Net - Famine and Early Warning Systems Network

FEWS Net is a leading provider of early warning and analysis on acute food insecurity. It was created by USAID to provide objective, evidence-based analysis to help government decision-makers and relief agencies plan for and respond to humanitarian crises.
