Withdrawing cash at ATMs: what to do and what to avoid

When you use an ATM:

- before and after use, wash hands for 20 seconds using soap and water or an alcohol-based hand sanitiser
- stay at least two metres away from other people
- cough or sneeze into your bent elbow
- say 'hello' without touching (do not shake hands)
- avoid touching your face
