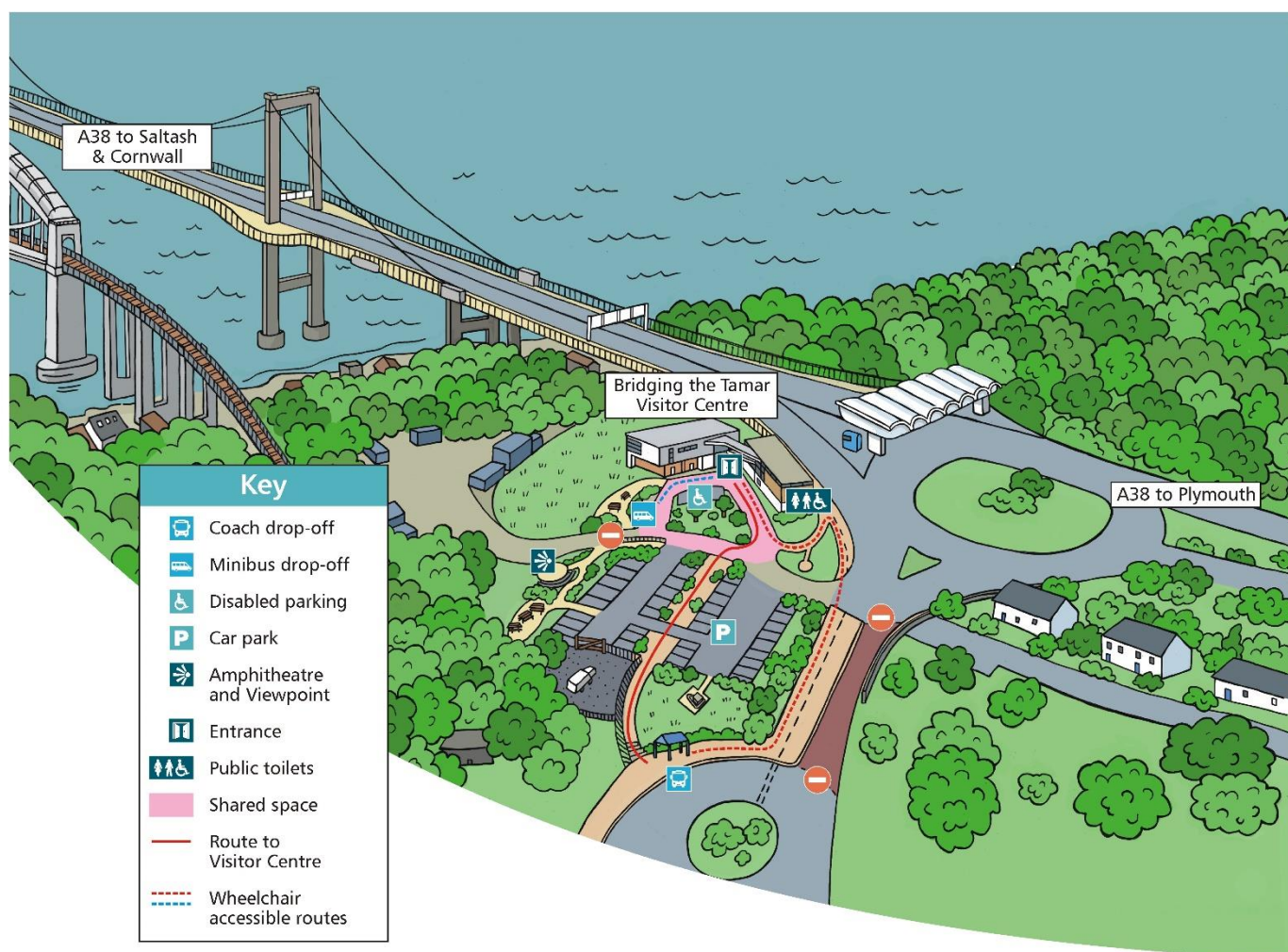


Bridging the Tamar Schools Workshop Welcome Pack

Arriving on site

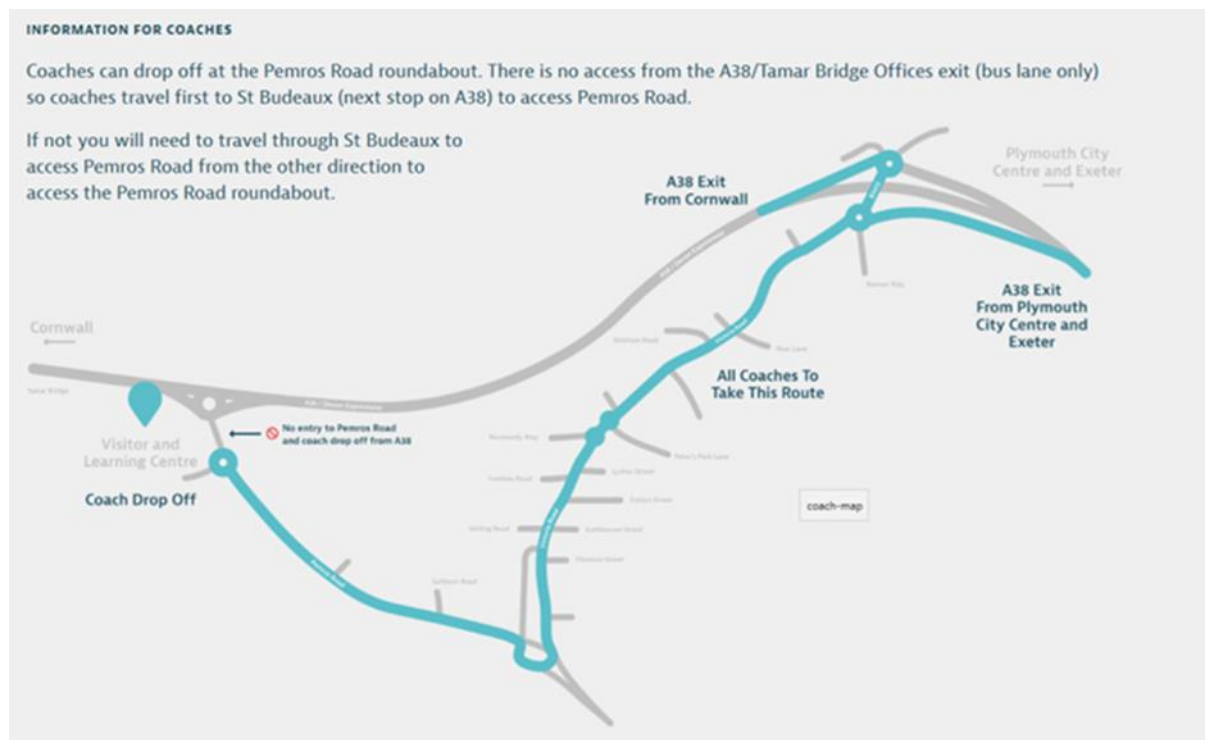
Arrival by foot, train or boat from Saltash

- From the Waterfront walk up Lower Fore Street to the footpath entrance of the Tamar bridge, just before you reach the Guildhall on the opposite side of the road.



- From the main station building turn right towards the two bridges public house, at the junction turn left into Albert Road, turn right into Station Road past the Church and Guildhall, turn right into Lower Fore Street just past the Guildhall on the opposite side of the road is the entrance to the footpath across the Tamar Bridge.

Arrival by coach



- The illustration shows important information about accessing the site by coach. **Please note the coach drop off is at the roundabout at the top of Pemros Road and you will need to travel through St Budeaux.**
- Please ensure all coach drivers are aware they cannot enter our car park from the A38 and they will not be able to use the bus priority lane to gain access to Pemros Road and the coach drop off point.
- We will meet you on at your vehicle your arrival and will be wearing high vis jackets. Please dismount from the coach and line the children up at the coach drop off point.

Arrival by minibus

- Please bear right on the way in towards the disabled parking and then pull in to minibus parking on the right, just next to the view and picnic bench.
- Please remember the car park is active and the area in front of the building is shared with vehicles.



- **Please remain in your vehicle. We will meet you on your arrival at your vehicle and will be wearing high vis jackets.**

Arrival by car

- Parking on site is limited.
- **If the car park is full it is NOT possible to access Pemros Road from our car park or vice versa (Bus lane).**
- If you park off-site around Pemros Road please be mindful of local residents (free on street parking).
- We will meet you on your arrival and will be wearing high vis jackets.
