FINDING KIDSCOVOLUNTEERS

Although the mission is compelling, finding volunteers is often a challenge. Help volunteers understand that while keeping kids entertained and safe is key to an excellent program, they are more than babysitters. They have the opportunity to tell each kid how much Jesus loves them. Understanding that ministry vision will help you build a dedicated team.

- current church kids program volunteers
- women's ministry
- small groups
- \cdot senior adult groups
- college students
- high school co-op
- homeschool groups
- partner with other MomCo Meetups

If finding volunteers is difficult, consider exploring alternative meeting times. Think about gathering at the same time as other church ministries with established childcare or during evening or preschool times when there is less of a demand for childcare. You might also consider rotating moms serving as helpers in the KidsCo rooms.
