from our music director

Leading the Toronto Symphony Orchestra throughout our extraordinary 2009.2010 season was a distinct privilege. We were fortunate to have outstanding composers, conductors, and guest artists such as Philip Glass, Gianandrea Noseda, Thomas Dausgaard, Maxim Vengerov, Pinchas Zukerman, Yundi Li, and Lang Lang visit our stage.

All music at some point was new music, and we can take pride in the contribution that the TSO makes to the birth of new music. Our sixth annual celebration of new music, the New Creations Festival, centered around the works of Argentinian composer Osvaldo Golijov and his examination of the relationship between words and music. And, last season, the TSO performed its newly commissioned works from outstanding composers Bramwell Tovey, Philip Glass, Peter Lieberon, Andrew Paul MacDonald, and the late Jacques Hétu.

The première of Jacques Hétu's Fifth Symphony, his last work, was a professional milestone for me. I have had the opportunity to give dozens of premières, but I had never premiered a work for orchestra and chorus. I am deeply grateful and honoured to have had the opportunity to help bring this music to the world and to have known this great Canadian composer.

Along with excellent artists and music, we also had the opportunity to perform the complete symphonies of Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. This Festival provided a unique chance to hear Sibelius' striking music in such a focused way.

Two new and exciting concert programming formats were introduced to Toronto audiences. The first, an idea brought to fruition by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, is called Beyond the Score®. We presented this programme during the Mozart@254 Festival and featured Canadian actor Paul Gross. This format allows the audience to learn what goes on behind their favourite pieces of music. The second idea was a late-night concert format with the performance beginning at 11:00pm. The late-night idea came about after I conducted a similar concert in Switzerland and thought that this was an idea that Toronto audiences would enjoy. The concert was a great success and introduced even more people to the TSO.

Music is such an important part of the life-blood of any great city. Toronto is such a city. I am proud of the music that we present to the people of our city, and I am grateful to those who make it possible.

I welcome our new Board members Blake Goldring, Stephen Grant, Andrea Hopson, Luke Seabrook, and Alina Osorio. Your involvement is a powerful indication that the Orchestra's work is important to our community.

09.10 artistic programme achievements

Commissions

The 2009.2010 season marked the TSO's largest investment in commissions in the history of the organization. Last season, the TSO commissioned a total of five new works from composers Bramwell Tovey, a new trumpet concerto written especially for TSO Principal Trumpet Andrew McCandless; Philip Glass (one of the most important American composers of our time), a new violin concerto based on the theme of Vivaldi's *Four Seasons* performed by violinist Robert McDuffie; Peter Lieberson, an orchestral suite from his first opera; Andrew Paul MacDonald, a new work for Canadian actor Colm Feore setting the poetry of Shelley; and the final symphony of the late Jacques Hétu.

Sibelius

Guest conductor Thomas Dausgaard led the Orchestra in a rare opportunity to hear all seven symphonies of Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. His symphonies were paired with his short violin works performed by violinist Pekka Kuusisto.

Late Night

In June 2010, the TSO offered its first ever "late-night" concert. This concert format, with the concert beginning at 11:00pm and running without an intermission, was implemented to attract an even more diverse audience and let those who have never or rarely attended a TSO performance experience an exciting live symphony orchestra concert. The concert was a success on all fronts, with a sold-out house and patrons remaining afterwards for a post-concert party in the lobby with live DJ entertainment.

Beyond the Score

Working to heighten patrons' concert experience and knowledge of classical music, in January 2010 the TSO presented a pilot performance of the much-lauded Beyond the Score® programme created by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. Mozart: Beyond the Score®, as part of the Mozart@254 Festival, featured Canadian actor Paul Gross and Peter Oundjian as narrators in a concert that included an exploration of Mozart's Piano Concerto No. 27 during the first half, and a complete performance of the work in the second.

Featured TSO musicians

The 88th season highlighted the talent within the TSO with solo appearances by Principal Clarinet Joaquin Valdepeñas performing Mozart's Clarinet Concerto, Principal Trumpet Andrew McCandless in the world première performance of Bramwell Tovey's *Songs of the Paradise Saloon*. Principal Horn Neil Deland and Principal Viola Teng Li were both featured during the Mozart@254 Festival. Neil, performing Mozart's Second Horn Concerto, and Teng, his *Sifonia concertante* for Violin and Viola with guest artist Anne Akiko Meyers.

The TSO released its fourth live recording in June 2010 under its own house label tsoLIVE. The recording featured the TSO's performance of Shostokovich's Symphony No. 7 "Leningrad" and was received with great acclaim.



finance & audit committee report

The Finance and Audit Committee of the Board of Directors is responsible for monitoring the finances and financial planning of The Toronto Symphony (TSO), and for reviewing the financial and administrative systems and controls. The Finance and Audit Committee meets with the auditors of the TSO at least annually to review the annual financial statements, and on other occasions as the Committee or the auditors of the TSO deem appropriate. Appointments to the Finance and Audit Committee are made by the Board.

During the year, management met regularly with the Finance and Audit Committee to review current financial results and planning for future fiscal periods. For complete audited financial statements call 416-593-7769 ext. 390.

While the long-term plan is to operate with a balanced budget, due to the difficult environment stemming from the economic crisis, the TSO operated with a deficit for the year ended June 30, 2010. Despite the difficult economic conditions throughout 2010, the TSO continued to serve and enrich the community as planned. With proactive compensation freezes and cuts, all members of the organization from musicians to staff contributed to the responsible and balanced cost-control measures to weather the challenging economy. Expenses remained tightly controlled and were below budget for the year. The bank operating line of credit was managed well within its limit and interest costs this year were lower than the prior year.


The Toronto Symphony Foundation (TSF) was incorporated in 1966 to support the Toronto Symphony Orchestra (TSO) in the advancement of orchestral music. The TSF operates separately from the TSO and is governed by a board of eleven Trustees (currently two vacancies). Funds invested by the TSF generate earnings that contribute to the annual funding distributions directed to the TSO to provide a stable and consistent revenue stream over the long term.

Donations received by the TSO each year as part of annual fundraising are used by the TSO to support ongoing operations. Contributions which donors wish to be invested and used to support the future operations of the TSO are deposited in the TSF and are managed by the Trustees in accordance with the directions of the donors.

During the TSO's 2010 fiscal year, the TSF provided a distribution of \$1,629,000. Since its inception, the TSF has received approximately \$30.9 million in contributions and has provided more than \$23.3 million to the TSO in annual distributions.

In 2010, the TSF received donations of \$2.05 million and experienced an investment gain of \$4.6 million.

The Foundation assets are maintained in three categories of Funds: General, Restricted, and Endowment. Contributions to the Foundation are allocated to a particular fund based on the wishes of the donor. The General Fund receives contributions from donors who have not specified a purpose for their gift. Use of the donations and net income earned on these funds is at the discretion of the Trustees. The Restricted Fund receives contributions from donors who have identified a specific purpose for the use of their gift and net income earned on these funds but do not require the gift to be held in perpetuity. The Endowment Fund receives contributions that are to be held in perpetuity.

Education & Outreach Programmes

The TSO continues its tradition of presenting curriculum-based music education programmes to the community. Over the course of the 09.10 season more than 47,000 young people from the ages of 5 to 18 travelled to Roy Thomson Hall to learn about and experience live orchestral music at a TSO Student Concert. Mornings with the TSO saw more than 2,000 high-school music students attend a TSO rehearsal to see and hear a professional orchestra in their final preparations before a concert.

As well as bringing young people to the hall, TSO Education Programmes take TSO musicians into the classroom to directly interact with students. In the TSO's Preludes programme, soloists and small ensembles visit schools to perform and demonstrate their instruments. With the Adopt-A-Player programme, a class of grade 4 or 5 students "adopts" a TSO musician who helps them compose their own piece of music. In the 09.10 season more than 20,000 young people participated in these initiatives.



Reaching communities across Ontario

During each season's annual Northern Residency Tour, Student Concerts are presented to the community, and TSO musicians visit local schools for Preludes performances and masterclasses. The 09.10 Northern Residency took place in Sudbury and Sault Ste. Marie. During the tour more than 9,000 young people participated in TSO Student Concerts (including one French-language concert) or experienced a Preludes presentation thanks to the generous support of the RBC Foundation, the Ontario Arts Council, and the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

How the Gimquat Found Her Song

The TSO released an interactive Teacher Resource Package - *How the Gimquat Found Her Song*, intended to assist teachers in delivering the new 2009 provincial music curriculum. The resource material, suitable for students from Kindergarten to Grade 5, includes a DVD of a children's symphonic performance featuring Peter Oundjian and the TSO, a compact disc of accompanying musical excerpts, instrument flashcards, and an in-depth Study Guide. This material was developed by the TSO in partnership with Platypus Theatre, Oz Media, and Connexionarts. This Study Guide was given free of charge to over 400 elementary schools in Northern Ontario during the TSO's Northern Residency tour.

toronto symphony committee report

The Toronto Symphony Volunteer Committee (TSVC) celebrated 87 years of continuing commitment to the Toronto Symphony Orchestra in 09.10. We are dedicated in our endeavours to the financial support of the Toronto Symphony Orchestra as well as to expanding awareness of its concert and educational programmes within the local community and beyond. Members devote much time and energy in supporting the TSO's education programmes through involvement with the Adopt-a-Player programme, Preludes, and Morning with the TSO.

Over the past decades, the TSVC has been, and continues to be, one of the largest TSO's donors by providing generous gifts both to the Toronto Symphony Foundation and the TSO Operations. This support is recognized by the two permanently endowed orchestra chair positions – the Toronto Symphony Volunteer Committee Principal Trumpet Chair and the Toronto Symphony Volunteer Committee Principal Flute Chair.

In 09.10 under the leadership of President Heather Oda in partnership with a dedicated Board and 220 members, the TSVC contributed \$130,000 to the TSO. Our fundraising was affected by the economic climate but nevertheless two of our most significant fundraisers were most successful. The Fine Wine Auction took place in a new elegant venue, which resulted in a larger attendance. Mozart unMasqued – a Birthday Gala celebrated Mozart at 254 with guest artists from the world of opera, TSO Principals and guest soloists. Our annual Flags at the Last Night of the Proms contributed significantly as well. This gift supports TSO operations, educational activities, and the Toronto Symphony Youth Orchestra.

During the 2009.2010 season, donors continued their support of the TSO and its commitment to excellent performances and education outreach initiatives. The support we receive from our donors, especially during the bleak economic climate, demonstrates the important place that the TSO has in our community.

Thanks to the generosity of individuals, corporations, and foundations, the TSO was able to raise over \$6 million dollars for the Annual Fund and the Toronto Symphony Foundation (TSF). Friends of the TSO increased their support from the previous year, and the number of donors to the TSO remained stable at over 6,500 for the 09.10 season.

The 09.10 season marked the launch of the TSO's Young Leadership Council, an initiative aimed to cultivate a new generation of TSO patrons, leaders, and supporters. To recruit members and raise awareness, a number of access events were held throughout the season where members had the opportunity to learn more about the TSO, classical music, and leadership at the TSO.

The funds raised for the TSO were done so at a cost of 28 cents for each dollar raised, comparing favourably to the industry standard of 35 cents per dollar raised.
