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ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival

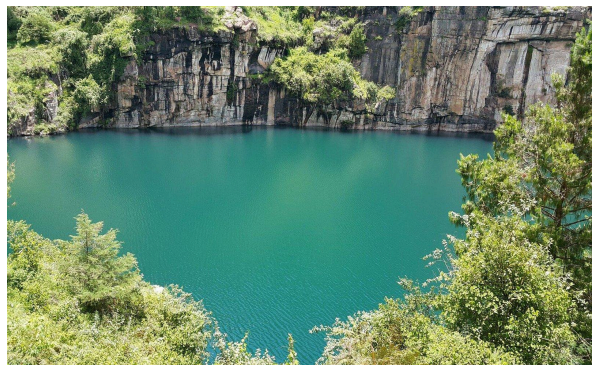
After your long flight, our tour guide and driver will pick you up at Antananarivo Airport and accompany you to the hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

Day 2: Antananarivo - Antsirabe

After breakfast you begin your journey by Motorcycle to the far south of Madagascar. You'll take your motorcycle for a test ride before you leave. The first day is dedicated to a trip to Antananarivo – Antsirabe via Ambatolampy. In Ambatolampy you can visit the Malagasy Marmite factory and then continue your journey to Antsirabe. Upon arrival in Antsirabe, you can explore the city after settling into your hotel until the evening. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

ANTSIRABE

Antsirabe is the capital of the Vakinankaratra region in the central highlands of Madagascar. It is a popular spa town, known for its thermal springs and the many colorful rickshaws. One of the city's French colonial buildings is the Hôtel des Thermes with its magnificent facade. The outdoor souk-like Sabotsy market sells clothing and local products. The large Lake Tritriva lies directly west of the city.



Day 3: Antsirabe - Miandrivazo

After breakfast you continue your journey to Miandrivazo. On your journey you will pass through beautiful landscapes and don't forget to take a break to enjoy the day and take great photos. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

MIANDRIVAZO

Miandrivazo is a charming town in Madagascar located near the Tsiribihina River. It is known for its warm climate and peaceful atmosphere. The town is a popular starting point for river trips, especially for those who want to explore the Tsiribihina River by pirogue (a type of canoe). Miandrivazo is also known for its picturesque sunsets over the river, making it a great place for photography and relaxation. The city is located about 220 km from Antsirabe and offers a significant difference in altitude and climate.



Day 4: Miandrivazo – Morondava

After breakfast at your hotel, continue your journey to Morondava, the capital of the Menabe region. Upon arrival, after checking into your hotel, you can take a city tour to discover the culture of the local population or enjoy the beach until the evening. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

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Day 5: Morondava – Bekopaka

After breakfast, you will embark on an adventurous journey along a sandy back road towards Bekopaka. You enter the baobab forest, where a road is lined with large trees over 20 m high. You will also cross the Tsiribihina and Manambolo rivers twice. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.



Day 6: Tsingy of Bemaraha

After breakfast, embark on a hike with a local guide through the incredible, spectacular Landscape of the Tsingy de Bemaraha. Your visit will last approximately 4 hours and at midday you will return to the hotel for lunch. In the afternoon you will discover the little Tsingy and the other surprising grotto. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

TSINGY BEMARAHA

Tsingy de Bemaraha is a remarkable nature reserve in the Melaky region of western Madagascar. It is known for its unique and dramatic limestone formations known as “Tsingy”, which means “walking on tiptoes” in Malagasy, as the rocks are very sharp. UNESCO World Heritage Site: The area was declared a World Heritage Site in 1990 due to its exceptional biodiversity and unique geological formations. Geological wonder: The area is a labyrinth of razor-sharp limestone peaks, deep canyons and gorges created by the erosion of limestone over millions of years. The reserve is home to a variety of endemic species including lemurs, birds and reptiles. It is a popular spot for adventurous travelers who enjoy hiking, climbing, and exploring the intricate cave systems and suspension bridges.

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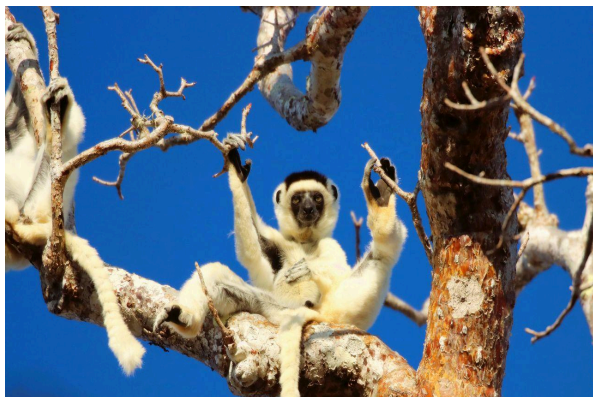


Day 7: Bekopaka – Kirindy

After breakfast you leave Bekopaka and drive back to Kirindy. In the evening, take a night tour of Kirindy Forest to spot nocturnal species such as the fosa and various lemurs. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

KIRINDY RESERVE

The Kirindy Reserve in western Madagascar is a fascinating destination known for its unique dry deciduous forest. It is part of the larger Kirindy-Mitea National Park and is located about 50 km northeast of Morondava. The reserve is home to a variety of species including the famous giant leaping rat, seven species of lemurs and numerous endemic reptiles. Iconic plants such as baobabs, hollies and euphorbias grow in the forest. The reserve has a dry season from March to December and a rainy season from December to March.

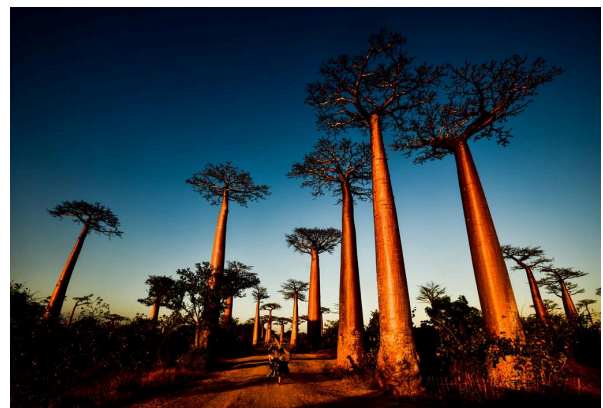
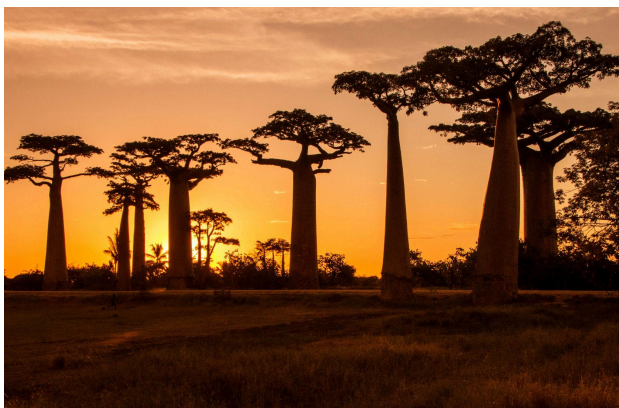


Day 8: Kirindy – Baobab Alley – Morondava

After breakfast, visit Kirindy Reserve with a local guide. It is an opportunity to discover the different species of birds as well as the endemic flora and fauna. Your visit lasts approximately 2 hours. Afterwards you leave your hotel and make your way to Morondava. Afterwards, enjoy the landscape of Madagascar's world-famous Baobab Avenue until sunset. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

AVENUE OF BAOBAB

The Avenue of the Baobabs is a breathtaking natural monument in the Menabe region of western Madagascar, between Morondava and Belon'i Tsiribihina. This dirt road is lined with majestic Grandidier's Baobabs (*Adansonia grandidieri*), which can grow up to 30 meters tall. Referred to locally as Renala, or “Mother of the Forest,” these ancient trees are remnants of the dense tropical forests that once thrived in this area. The Avenue of the Baobabs is not only a popular tourist destination, but also a symbol of local conservation efforts. In 2007 it was temporarily placed under protection, a step towards becoming Madagascar's first natural monument. Despite its popularity, the area is threatened by deforestation, agricultural encroachment and bushfires.



Day 9: Morondava – Belo sur Mer

After breakfast you continue your adventurous journey along a sandy road to Belo sur Mer. It is a small coastal village in the western Menabe region of Madagascar, known for its picturesque landscape, the traditional fishing village of Vezo and its shipbuilding heritage. On arrival check in at the hotel.

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Day 10: Relax in Belo sur Mer

This is a special day for you as a free district. You can do any activities you want, such as swimming in the sea, meeting the local population, visiting the fishing village of Vezo, etc. Don't forget that all paid activities are at your own expense. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

BELO SUR MER

Belo sur Mer is a charming coastal village in the Menabe region of Madagascar. The village is known for its traditional boat building and is famous for the construction of “boutres”, the traditional sailing ships. The village offers stunning white sandy beaches and crystal clear waters perfect for swimming, snorkeling and relaxing. The native Vezo people are known for their fishing and navigation arts. You can get to know their culture by visiting fishing villages and tasting the local cuisine. Belo sur Mer is home to a marine park with a diverse underwater world, ideal for diving and exploring underwater ecosystems. Experience the craftsmanship of local boat builders who create traditional wooden boats using traditional techniques.

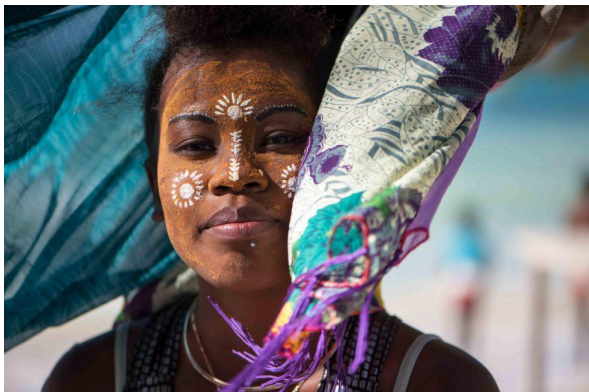


Day 11: Belo sur Mer – Morondava

After breakfast, drive your car back to Morondava. When you arrive in Morondava, if you wish, you can stroll around the town until the evening and get to know the culture of the Menabe ethnic group. But if you get tired from the trip, you can relax at the hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

MORONDAVA

Morondava is a charming coastal town in the Menabe region of Madagascar. It is known for its breathtaking natural beauty and cultural richness. Morondava is home to the Sakalava and Vezo ethnic groups, whose rich traditions and customs you can learn about, including the “asa lolo” ceremony and “tromba” rituals.



Day 12: Morondava – Antananarivo (Flug 2h)

After breakfast you have the opportunity to buy souvenirs in the town of Morondava until lunch. At midday, the guide will take you to Morondava Airport for your flight to Antananarivo. The motorcycle trip ends here. Upon arrival, another driver and tour guide will meet you at the airport and accompany you to your hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

Day 13: City tour of Antananarivo

After breakfast, embark on a city tour with a guide to discover the capital of Madagascar. Make the most of your day as your stay is coming to an end soon. So don't miss the opportunity to buy some souvenirs. In the afternoon, we returned to the hotel. Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

ANTANANARIVO

Antananarivo, the capital of Madagascar, is full of must-see highlights and attractions. The Royal Hill of Ambohimanga is a historical site that is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It offers breathtaking views and an insight into Madagascar's royal history. The Queen's Palace (Rova) is an iconic structure located on one of the city's hills and offers panoramic



views of Antananarivo. The Analakely Market: A lively market where you can discover local products and crafts and sample Malagasy cuisine.



Day 14: Departure

After breakfast, you can shop for souvenirs as your stay in Madagascar draws to a close. At midday, the driver and tour guide will take you to Antananarivo International Airport, from where you will fly back to your country. We thank you for your trust and look forward to the next time.
