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There's never been a better time to dine out in this pink-sand paradise.

When Bermuda hosted the 35th America's Cup in 2017, it marked a significant shift in the island's restaurant scene. With much of the world watching, this mid-Atlantic archipelago collectively stepped up its food game, courting big-name chefs like Marcus Samuelsson to open new restaurants and enticing old guard favorites to shine up tired menus. What exists now is a dynamic new culinary landscape—one that goes far beyond the British pub grub, Caribbean-inspired comfort food, and fresh-from-the-ocean seafood it's long been known for. Here, we've rounded up a few of our favorites; welcome to Bermuda, where your taste buds will be dazzled and your seaside table awaits.

RESTAURANT

Beau Rivage →

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At Beau Rivage, chef Jean Claude Garzia, a winner of the coveted *Meilleur Ouvrier de France*, turns out perfect classical French cuisine at his restaurant on the grounds of **Newstead Belmont Hills Golf Resort & Spa**. Start with the foie gras served with a sauternes wine sauce and fig marmalade, move onto a bowl of creamy lobster bisque, then dig into the roasted lamb chops (served Provençal style, of course). Desserts are everything you'd expect—buttery, decadent, and yes, French—but the *crème brûlée*, apple tarte tatin, and daily homemade soufflé all take the, uh, cake.
