Newstead Belmont Hills Golf Resort & Spa →

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Bermuda is home to a handful of boutique hotels where you’ll get a blissful water view—without any beach or sand. Perched on the shores of Hamilton Harbour, where boats routinely make way for dozens of islets and cays, Newstead Belmont Hills Golf Resort & Spa is one of them. If its wordy nomenclature is any indication, there’s a lot more going on at this uniquely modern hotel than meets the eye, so walk through the chic, glassed-in lobby, grab your complimentary Bermuda rum swizzle at the bar, and enjoy the view. There’s also a complimentary airport shuttle, plus a free round of golf at the 6,100-yard ocean-view course—among Bermuda’s best.
