Plant Explorer

Become an explorer for the day and discover fascinating facts about the plants growing in the garden; where they come from and what uses they have. The trail booklet contains a map and spaces for children to draw or provide a rubbing of the answer.

Mr. Frog's Wildlife Trail

An exciting trail for the very young to discover all the animals, birds and insects that live in Trebah Garden. Follow the map to find the ten trail posts of Mr Frog and name the animals beneath him, then answer the questions about the animals.

Trebah Beach

The bottom of the garden opens out onto Trebah Beach on the banks of the Helford River one of the cleanest waterways in Britain and from where you can look out to sea. Trebah Beach has its place in history as the embarkation point of the 29th US Infantry division bound for the D-Day assault on Omaha Beach.

Tarzan's Camp, Paraglide and Fort Stuart

An adventure play area with climbing frames and ropes sheltered beneath a giant cedar tree with bark chip flooring. The paraglide is an aerial slide for adventurous 4 – 14 year old children weighing less than seven stone. The wooden climbing frame may be slippery in wet weather.

Fort Stuart is a play area for children under five years of age.

Gift Shop and Trebah Kitchen

Trebah Garden Gift Shop offers a selection of postcards, souvenirs, children's games and books both educational and fun. Ice cream, soft drinks, sandwiches, meals and snacks are available in the Cafè. **Please let us know in advance of any catering requirements.**

The Vinery

A room situated in the garden for storage of bags and packed lunches. Please leave the room as you find it. Bins and brooms are provided to help tidy up.

Payment should be made enbloc at the entrance on arrival. **We are only able to invoice after the event by prior arrangement.** Organisers are welcome to make preliminary visits, no charge will be made if by prior appointment.

Guidelines for Teachers and Youth Leaders

To retain the special atmosphere of the garden, we ask organisers to abide by the following guidelines:-

- To limit the size of each group visiting the garden to a maximum of 50 children accompanied by the correct number of supervising adults.
- Supervision in the garden, on the beach and on all play equipment is **essential at all times** please and children should be kept in small groups while in the garden.
- Ensure the children are aware of the other visitors in the garden, some of whom are elderly and infirm and have come to enjoy the peace and quiet.
- Ensure that the children stay on the paths, do not pick, interfere or damage any of the plants, and do not drop litter (litter bins are provided in the garden).
- To be responsible for the welfare, behaviour and safety of the children .

Failure to meet these requirements will result in your school being excluded from Trebah Garden.

Please note: Paths and edges of ponds can be slippery in wet weather. The Trust has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of its visitors but cannot accept responsibility for misuse of facilities.
