Champagne & Prosecco

- S1 Taittinger NV Brut Reserve €130**
The palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony. This is a delicate wine with flavours of fresh fruit and honey.
- S5 Dom Perigean Moët & Chandon 2006 €295**
Stylish glittering pale gold with tiny flowing bubbles. Chardonnay scents lead into citrus fruits with floral lilac and snowdrop aromas.
- S4 Cristal Louis Rogederer 2007 €395**
A silky texture and fruity aromas, complemented by a powerful mineral quality with white fruit and citrus notes.
- S11 Prosecco Frizzante, Villa Arfanta DOC Treviso €42**
Fruity bouquet; fresh, harmonious palate. Enjoy as an aperitif or with food.
- S12 Prosecco Spumante Sgajo Extra Dry, Perlage Valdobbiadene N/V (Organic / Vegan) €59**
Fruity with notes of apple, apricot and banana; fresh, long and persistent.

White

New Zealand, Spain

- T4 Sauvignon Blanc –Tindall Vineyard, Marlborough €39**
Fresh and Lively aromas of passion fruit, Limes & Floral notes.
- T5 Atlantic Way Albarino Rias Baixas €39.50** *Aromas of ripe fruits with hints of apple, pineapple and citrus fruit. Rounded, well balanced palate with great length and a lingering finish.*

France

- T2 Macon Lugny Saint Pierre Burgundy €49**
Fresh nose offering a lovely bouquet of wild flowers. Pleasant, very perfumed and nicely rounded on the palate.
- T8 Sancerre -Blush Roland Tissier et Fils 2017 €59**
The wine is fresh, so crisp and fruity. Its red currant fruit and lively acidity are rounded out by a caramel flavor that gives richness. The aftertaste though is dry and packed with fruit

A7 Puligny Montrachet - Louis Latour 2016 €125
Round with notes of white fruits and almonds, with an elegant woodiness, a touch of brioche and hints of vanilla.

B3 Neyret-Gachet - Château-Grillet 2010 €295
Such a unique Viognier, with a honied tone, rich and viscous, yet just a little floral, at it's best when given some time to breath.

Germany & Slovenia

C3 Riesling Trittenheimer Apotheke, Mosel 2011 €84
Waves of smoke and crushed stone - it's round and a bit creamy on the palate, brightened by a bristle of acidity and a steely finish.

D1 Pinot Gris – Verus, Štajerska 2016 €52
Crunchy, green apple fruitiness balanced by mouth-watering, zesty, lemony acidity, some peach, honey and floral tones and a very appealing, clean, fresh finish.

USA & Italy

F9 Sauvignon Blanc - Pradio, Friuli 2016 €42
Up in North East Italy, Friuli produces some wonderfully fresh, aromatic whites. Gianni Menotti has been awarded "Best Winemaker in Italy" and this demonstrates why.

E5 Chardonnay - Cakebread, Napa Valley 2015 €140
Long finish lifted by zesty spice and mineral tones. Beautifully balanced.

E9 Chardonnay Chateau Montelena 2014 €125
One of the few California Chardonnays that behaves like a Grand Cru Chablis. Exhibits a nervous edge as well as loads of lemon butter.

Red

France

I2 Château Sénéjac Cru Bourgeois 2014 €70
Same owners as Ch. Talbot - this is classic mature Bordeaux & is drinking wonderfully now. Blackcurrant & cedar flavours; medium-bodied, lovely freshness & balance.

I11 Chateau Batailley Pauillac 2009 €240
Very smooth and silky for a Pauillac with a touch of cedar. Succulent tannins, very refined with a spicy, vibrant finish.

- I17** **Château Lynch-Bages Pauillac 2000** **€885**
An utterly profound Lynch-Bages, this wine could be a hypothetical blend of the outstanding 1990 and 1989.
- I7** **Château Lafite Rothschild 1er Grand Cru Classe Pauillac 1998** **€1450**
Effortless racy elegance of an older Cabernet Sauvignon with its truffles, smoked cedar, its grilled black fruits.
- I21** **Château La Crox Fourney St. Emilion Grand Cru 201** **€70**
Rich, full-bodied and complex. Inky and concentrated with dusty, soft tannins and great length.
- J1** **Bourgogne Pinot Noir - Domaine Pascal Henry 2015** **€50**
Fresh red silky fruit and bright acidity with a clean, long finish and a hint of spices. Excellent.
- K6** **Gigondas Cret St Sauveur 2014** **€75**
Full bodied, very classy wine with a rich note of plums and herbs; great structure and wonderful ripeness. Real style in a powerful, rich wine.

Germany & Italy

- K16** **Blaufrankisch – Weingut Moric, Burgenland 2012** **€59**
Similar to a top Cote Rotie from the Rhone. The spicy mineral nose is fresh and peppery. Savoury palate with spicy, mineral notes.
- M8** **Chianti Classico DOCG Da Vinci 2011** **€55**
Vibrant fresh plum, blackberry and spice aromas. Full-bodied on the palate with soft supple tannins.
- M6** **Dezzani Barolo ‘San Carlo’** **€84**
Red garnet in colour with a complex nose of rose petals and autumn leaves, this is a serious Barolo with flavours of red berries, spices with overtones of woodsmoke and toast and a velvety feel on the tongue.
- M21** **Amarone Riserva Della Valpolicell, Sergio Zenato Veneto 2011** **€260**
Italian meditation wine! The praise heaped on this by the international press is well-founded.

Spain & Argetina

- N1** **Priorat - Inicial, Barcelona 2011** **€49**
Dark Mature Fruits, with mild oak aging. Smooth and rich.
- N4** **Rioja Conde Valdemar Reserve 2010** **€70**
Notes of cocoa, spice, & chocolate. subtle aromas of ripe dark-berried fruit. Polished tannins with a very long finish.
- P1** **Malbec Reserva - Mendoza, Francois Lurton 2014** **€47.50**
Spice combines with toasted notes and the characteristic red berry fruit of Malbec.

USA

- Q2** **Zinfandel Chateau Montelena 2014** **€110**
Aromas of raspberry, cedar, dried fruit and the classic Zinfandel briar-berry with hints of pipe tobacco and dusty cocoa.
- Q5** **Cabernet Sauvignon - Cakebread Napa Valley (Organic) 2013** **€265**
Luxurious dark cherry, boysenberry, blackcurrant and black fig aromas, scents of oak toast and dark chocolate.

New Zealand & Australia

- U2** **Te Pa Pinot Noir, Marlborough** **€58**
A superbly intense pinot noir with dark cherries and crunchy summer berries on the nose. On the palate there are raspberries, cherries and wild bramble fruits with a rich, smooth texture.
- Q30** **Cabernet Sauvignon Limited Release** **€110**
O'Dwyer Winery, Clare Valley 2013
Mulberry and red fruits, dusty tannins and subtle oak, elegant style, with fine acid and longevity in the bottle.
