

Kids at 12Stone FAQ

When will Children's Ministry open?

Our children's services are now open at our 6 open campuses. Check locations and registration for availability at 12stone.com.

Do I need to register before bringing my child to Children's Ministry?

Yes, we ask all families to register their children to ensure our environments are as safe as possible. You can register you and your child at 12stone.com/Sundays.

What if we register but can't make it to service?

If you can't make it to your registered Sunday service, you can unregister at 12stone.com/Sundays.

What should I do if my child isn't feeling well?

Engage in 12Stone Home! If you or your child has any of the following symptoms, we ask that you enjoy service at home: cough, shortness of breath, chills, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, muscle pain, fever, runny nose, nausea or vomiting, fatigue, headache, and poor appetite.

Can I bring a diaper bag for my toddler?

We ask that families leave all personal belongings at home, but don't worry, our rooms are well-stocked with diapers, wipes, and training pants. If your child requires a special brand of diaper, please put the diaper of your choice in a large storage bag.

Can I bring a diaper bag for my baby?

For babies in the Nursery, you may pack a pre-made bottle, pacifier on a clip, and an extra onesie in a storage bag.

Will you feed my child a snack?

Of course! We will serve individual, pre-packaged snacks of Cheerios in the Nursery and Animal Crackers in Preschool.

What if my child has an allergy?

You may send an individual portion of a snack of your choice in a storage bag.

What steps are you taking to keep my child safe?

We're glad you asked! We are taking many steps to keep all of our kids and volunteers safe:

- Temperature checks for all staff, volunteers, and families entering our Children's areas
- Masks for all staff and volunteers
- Touchless check-in and check-out for our kids and parents
- One-way traffic and social-distancing markers in our Children's hallway
- Limiting our Children's hallways to one parent/guardian and child(ren) whenever possible
- Reduced capacity in all of our Children's environments and smaller volunteer-to-child ratios
- Maintaining children in one environment for the service

Does everyone in my family need to get his or her temperature checked?

Anyone who enters our Children's areas will need to have a temperature check. We will ask anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher to engage in 12Stone Home that weekend.

Does my child need to wear a mask?

Masks are recommended, but not required.

Will the staff wear a mask?

Yes, absolutely!
