In Isaiah 9:6, Jesus is characterized as a Mighty God and when we come face to face with the Mighty God, he requires a Mighty response. If Jesus is the Mighty King, how will we respond this Christmas season?

DID YOU KNOW? | MEANINGFUL GIFTS

Did you know that the gifts that the Wisemen brought to Jesus' birth had great meaning to Jesus as our Messiah. Gold was a gift that represented his kingship as it was only given as a gift to those who belong to a royal family. Frankincense was a gift that affirmed Jesus as our God as it was often used in religious worship ceremonies and lastly Myrrh symbolized Jesus' sacrifice for us since it was used as an embalming agent when people passed.
