In Exodus 17, Moses fights a battle through prayer while Joshua fights the physical battle against the Amalekites. When Moses raises his hands, Joshua is winning the battle but when he lowers his hands, the Amalekites begin to win. This passsage shows us through Moses that God can help us fight battles worth fighting for through our "Hands Up Prayers". #### TELL ME THE TRUTH I EXODUS 17:11-13

"(11) As long as Moses held up his hands, the Israelites were winning, but whenever he lowered his hands, the Amalekites were winning. (12) When Moses' hands grew tired, they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it. Aaron and Hur held his hands up—one on one side, one on the other—so that his hands remained steady till sunset. (13) So Joshua overcame the Amalekite army with the sword."

Through the story of Moses and Joshua, we see the power of praying and working toward the will of God. When we combine prayer and action, God is able to move through both the spiritual and physical world.

- Q: What is so important about Moses' posture of raising his hands?
- Q: Is our posture during prayer important? Why or why not?
- Q: What is one area of your life where you can engage in Hands Up Prayer?
