TELL ME THE TRUTH | ACTS 4:24-31

"(24) When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God. 'Sovereign Lord,' they said, 'you made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. (25) You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our David: Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? (26) The king of the earth will rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against the anointed one. (27) Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together the with Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. (28) They did what your power and will had decided beforehand should happen. (29) Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. (30) Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus.' (31) After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly."

Throughout Scripture, God gives us examples of how to pray. He shows us that prayer is relational and practical. It's relational because it allows us to get closer to Him; it's practical because He asks us to pray daily. The Lord's Prayer says, "Give us this day our daily bread." We can go to Him for companionship and guidance in our everyday.
