Rocket City Church

Here's a story from Brian Bradford, the founding pastor of Rocket City Church, our church plant in Huntsville, Alabama:

LeAnn and her family moved here last summer. Her husband, Ray, is a full Colonel in the Army and got stationed here at Redstone Arsenal. He works directly for the 4-star general. He's never been to church. She's been sporadically and was praying when they moved here that God would find a church for them ALL to go to. We and another Rocket City Church family met them walking in our neighborhood. We connected on social media and found out about the church. She came alone the first Sunday and then returned with the kids the next Sunday. That afternoon, her husband returned from a work trip and she told him that she had attended church with the girls. Literally, his response according to him and her: You did WHAT?!?!

Anyway, long story short, they joined a life group, their girls, Alannah and Aaliyah got saved & baptized on Easter Sunday. Now he and I work out together at 5am and he joined my monthly men's leadership group. We had our final meeting this morning at 6am. I asked the guys to summarize what they've learned over the last three months and three books, to which he said: I've now realized that I have to reprioritize my life and future around things that matter.
