## VISION

**Residency** We have 11 new residents that started since June of 2022. The annual investment for a resident is

\$17,500 and gives the resident the opportunity to earn a Master of Arts in Ministry Leadership

from Wesley Seminary.

**Student Retreats** The highest number of life change stories are from these retreats. Students are a part of

Community Groups and, on a retreat experience nearly a semester's worth of time to build trust, grow in the community, and give the students and their leader a foundation to build from when they get home. A \$75K investment offsets significant price increases and pressures of the current economic environment so that the retreat price can stay the same as in prior years and doubles the number of scholarships for students that can't afford to attend. Our goal is to scholarship 350

students to retreats this year.

**Next Gen Creative** 12Stone has always existed for the Next Generation. This is even more important coming out of

the pandemic. A \$150K investment allows us to upgrade the film studio where all our Next Gen content is created. It also provides the resources necessary to create, develop and enhance our curriculum, volunteer training, and the overall experience for Kids and Students at 12Stone.
