### VISION

#### “Local” Recovery Centers

The opportunity to serve individuals struggling with addiction is on the rise coming out of the pandemic. Two of our partners, Recovery Foundations ([www.recoveryfoundations.org](http://www.recoveryfoundations.org)) and Lightway Recovery ([www.lightwayrecovery.org](http://www.lightwayrecovery.org)), could strategically advance their services with an additional \$50K in funding.

#### Jambos

12Stone’s partnership with Jambos ([www.jambosdonates.com](http://www.jambosdonates.com)) has resulted in explosive growth as they continue to provide comfort to kids in the foster system. Over the last three years, we have collected 41,710 pairs of pajamas for Jambos! In December 2022, we provided Jambos with a \$50K grant to ship pajamas to kids in foster care across all 50 states. As Jambos grows, they need a larger vehicle for the transportation of pajamas, and a \$35K investment meets this need.

#### Adults with Special Needs

An opportunity for this quarter is to support adults with special needs. This group typically needs more access to government assistance. Two of our partners, Exceptional Foundations of Atlanta ([www.efatl.org](http://www.efatl.org)) and Annandale Village ([www.annandale.org](http://www.annandale.org)), provide training, care, and support for adults with special needs. An investment of \$50K for each organization increases their capacity to serve the needs of this community.

## SUCCESS STORIES

### Jambos Continues to Grow

A group of Legacy Builders met at the Jambos warehouse in Buford on January 7th, 2023. They met with the founder, Rebekah Black. Rebekah shared how Jambos was founded when she discovered the need for brand-new pajamas for children coming into foster care. Many of whom had nothing but the clothes on their backs. The first pajamas were sorted, rolled, and packaged on her dining room table to Gwinnett County DFCS and surrounding agencies.

As Jambos began to grow, 12Stone stepped in for our first Christmas collection in December 2020. At that time, Jambos was in 5 states and three countries. 12Stone's involvement over the past three Christmas collections has helped provide the pajamas needed for Jambos to grow its influence in such a way that they are now in all 50 states and have sent pajamas to 13 countries. In 2022, Jambos moved into a warehouse with over 7000 square feet.

It felt like every Legacy Builder in attendance was moved to tears, then laughter, then gratitude that we are part of a church serving one of our partners so well. Those in attendance were told that in December, based on the generosity of so many 12Stoners through Legacy Builders and the Christmas offering; our church gave

Jambos a grant for \$50,000 to help distribute the 13,000 pair of pajamas 12Stone collected in December of 2022. In three years of collections, 12Stone has collected almost 45,000 pairs of pajamas, over 60% of the total collected since Jambos began.
