12Stone Home is gatherings of 8-12 people meeting in coffee shops, homes, and community centers. City Pastors are 12Stone staff pastors bringing 12Stone Home to a City to saturate that city with 12Stone Home Gatherings. Through your generosity, our first City Pastor, Zach Otto, launched in Charleston, SC, in December of 2022 and already has over 20 people worshipping together in Charleston.

We are targeting two additional City Pastors across the following cities: Greenville, SC; Augusta, GA; and Asheville, NC. The first-year launch cost to reach one of these cities is \$100K each.
