Homelessness One of the ongoing opportunities in our community is to serve those in homelessness. Two of our partners, Rainbow Village (www.rainbowvillage.org) and Home of Hope (www.homeofhopegcs.org) are leading the way in providing transitional housing, family services, and career services. An investment of \$25K allows these organizations to continue to expand their services and increase capacity.

Food Insecurity in 12Stone Home Cities We have 12Stone Home Gatherings in several cities where food insecurity is a pressing issue. We will invest \$5000 in 4 cities (Charleston, SC; Dallas, TX; Port Orchard, Washington & Spokane, Washington) to serve these families in need.

Equip 12Stone and Equip have an ongoing partnership to train believers to share their faith within their circles of influence, often in the business community. The goal for Equip in 2023 is to see 400,000 decisions for Christ this year.
