## SUCCESS STORIES

We are thrilled to announce the launch of a Monday night service at the Braselton campus starting on August 19th at 7 pm. Two significant reasons drive this decision.

Our first and foremost goal is to provide a service for those who are unable to attend church on Sundays due to various commitments and responsibilities. We believe in the importance of offering a worship option for those in our community when Sundays don't work for them. The Monday night service will be a unique opportunity for new visitors to connect with our church family and grow in their faith.

Secondly, our vibrant Braselton community has seen incredible growth. Our prime-time services are consistently at 90-110% capacity, with 5-7 new families showing up EVERY week. This growth and the feedback from our community inspired our decision to launch

another service. We are striving to ensure that everyone has a welcoming and comfortable experience at our church, and we believe this new service will be a collective effort to accommodate our growing community.

In addition to these reasons, we will do anything to reach and serve the one. For example, there is a single dad who shares custody of his two daughters. He gets his girls on the weekend, and when they come to church, he drops them off in a k12 room and then attends the service. With the option of a Monday night service, he's choosing to attend service on Monday nights, and when he comes to church on Sundays with his daughters, he's going to serve in k12 in the same rooms his daughters are in, so he can spend more time with them. When you don't have many hours together, an extra hour means everything.
