Key Thoughts and Reflections:

I. Family is God's Design

Q: Read today's key scripture. What was the first command that God gave mankind? Share some reasons why this is important in God's design for the family.

Q: Compare Matthew 12:50 with Genesis 1:28. How does humanity's mission to be fruitful and multiply relate to Jesus' calling to do the will of the Father? Why are these two missions important in the Kingdom of God?

Q: What are some ways that Satan will attempt to thwart these two missions?

II. Chase Divine Design

Q: God's design for family is like that of a round wheel—the round design makes life roll. Satan's counterfeit redefinitions can be likened to a square wheel, which does not roll and can go nowhere. Name some square-wheel counterfeit redefinitions of family in marriage, parenting, identity, etc. that can lead to dysfunction.

Q: Paul teaches us in Ephesians 5:1-2 two things that lead to unity and maturity. How can these keep us from falling into the enemy's snare? How might living this out lead to a healthy family? Q: What are some practical ways that we can chase God's divine design in both the nuclear and church family?

III. Choose Godly Things

Q: In 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, Paul teaches that we are one family united under Jesus. What does he warn against in the remainder of the passage?

Q: Name some ways that division can tear a family apart?

Q: Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8. What is God calling us into that resolves the problem of division? Share some practical ways these are lived out and how they can lead to unity.

Get Practical _

Take time this week to be still before the Lord and ask Him to show you where He wants to align you and your family with His design. Are you moving forward in His round wheel definition of family? Or do you feel stuck? Over the next seven days, commit to praying for both your immediate family and your church family. Journal 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 three times. The first time, write the scripture as is. The second time, exchange love for your name. The third time, write God in exchange for love. Love is a fruit of His Spirit. Ask Him to pour His love into you and to show you how to pour His love into those within your family.
