Lily Pearman is a mixed media textiles artist whose practice explores home, memory, and cultural heritage. Her studio practice is rooted in personal experience, with pieces shaped by family identity, generational spaces, and the emotional significance of place. Guided by values of sustainability and storytelling, she employs a multidisciplinary process that includes appliqué, sublimation, lino printing, hand and digital embroidery to transform expressive, loosely drawn florals into sculptural textile forms.
