


Medical Care for Small Animals in the Community of Chorrillos



UPC's Veterinary Medicine Program, through its Veterinary Medical Center, provided medical care to small animals in the District of Chorrillos from April to December 2021. The service provided consisted of the evaluation of and provision of veterinary medical care to pets from areas surrounding the Villa campus. Vaccines, baths and medical care were subsidized at 50%.

The Veterinary Medical Center has the highest level of infrastructure, equipment and the best team of veterinarians that provide quality care. Likewise, students of the program carry out internships supervised by faculty members, complementing their professional training.



Volunteering



UPC's Veterinary Medicine Program, through its Veterinary Medical Center, organized a volunteering program from August 6 to 8, 2021. Students perform check-ups and treat patients under constant supervision of the Veterinary Doctor.





Virtual Platform of the Organization "Kaprichos Perrunos" Volunteering Program



UPC's Veterinary Medicine Program organized a volunteering program from April 4 to July 7, 2021. The service provided consisted of the design of the virtual platform of Kaprichos Perrunos with the aim of linking interested students with external volunteering opportunities. This volunteering program supports shelters, animals in a state of abandonment and promotes sterilization campaigns.

Kaprichos Perrunos is a non-profit civil association that promotes responsible pet ownership and brings voluntary help to various shelters through visits and donations in Lima.

UPC's Veterinary Medicine Program organized the education campaign for the residents of Surco, which was held in El Pensador Park on May 20, 2021.

Veterinary Medicine students were able to talk with the neighbors about good practices for handling and caring for pets.



Internships for Work with Small Animals



UPC's Veterinary Medicine Program organized internships for work with small animals at the Rondón Veterinary Clinic from August to November 2021. The students had contact with real life cases in the veterinary clinic and developed their professional skills.

The Rondón Veterinary Clinic is located in the District of Santiago de Surco. It is a company that provides veterinary, petshop and grooming services for pets.



Adogta Amor



The virtual event "Adogta Amor" was held on November 21, 2021, which included the participation of UPC's Audiovisual Communication and Interactive Media Program. The purpose of this event was to benefit the animals of the Mister Cobaya Shelter, a non-profit organization.

The main objective of the activity was to help promote the responsible adoption of abandoned puppies and provide them with a home. Adogta Amor intended to promote responsible adoption and provide information on the subject to the interested public.

For this first edition of Adogta Amor, experts were invited to provide information on the problems caused by the abandonment of pets and non-responsible ownership. In this way, greater awareness is raised in the community, since this leads to the development of other social problems such as the increase in diseases.
