# **1. ENTRY RULES & CONDITIONS**

Registration is available directly on the website <u>puerto-vallarta.utmb.world</u> from January 8th, 2024 at 12:00:00 Central Time.

Registrations will be made exclusively on the internet and payment will be made by credit card.

### Sales period:

Registration will be open to the runners with a valid UTMB index only from January 8<sup>th</sup> 2024 at 12:00:00 hrs until January 10th 2024 at 23:59:59 hrs

At the end of this period, registrations will be open to all runners with or without valid UTMB index until October 19th, 2024 at 23:59:00 or until the races are sold out. There will be no waiting list.

- 100M WIXÁRIKA: 200 slots
- 100K HIKURI: 500 slots
- 50K NAKAWÉ: 800 slots
- 33K HARAMARA: 400 slots
- 20K ERENO: 400 slots
- 8K PATA SALADA: 300 slots

### Minimum age:

Registrations to WIXÁRIKA & HIKURI are open to anyone over 20 years of age on the day of the race.

Registrations to NAKAWÉ & HARAMARA are open to anyone over 18 years of age on the day of the race.

Registration to ERENO & PATA SALADA are open to anyone over 16 years of age on the day of the race.

The registration is nominative. It is not allowed to transfer the registration to another race.

### **Elite Runners:**

In order to give fair recognition to high level athletes and to ensure a fair management of entry applications, we reserve places for elite athletes according to their Performance Index in the category of the race they chose to compete. Elite runners must register during the registration period. No registration will be accepted after the deadline.

Runners meeting the criteria may benefit from the above registration conditions.





### **2. REGISTRATION**

Prices include VAT (16%) registration fee.

An additional 8% administration fee will be charged. Those administration fees are not refundable in case of cancelation.

Medical expenses and evacuation: This insurance is mandatory for all participants, as it specifically covers any mishap in mountain races in Mexico, especially medical assistance, including transfers by helicopter or by land. Insurance cost: 15 USD.

## **3. WHAT IS INCLUDED**

- Race Bib
- Welcome gift
- Access to aid stations
- Transport to the start line (100M, 100k & 20K) \*Only confirmed at deadline
- Transport of the spare bags (100M & 100K)
- Medical assistance
- Finisher Medal

### **4. DISTANCE CHANGES**

The deadline to make a change at registered distance is until 2024 October 12th, according to the following considerations:

- In case to changing to a shorter distance, there will be no refund for the fee difference.
- In case to changing to longest distance, the amount corresponding to the fee difference must be covered and additional 15 USD as a penalized coast.
- Registration is transferable to another person, the register transfer will have a 15 USD cost, and it must be done through <u>ablanco@grupoochoa.com.mx</u> mailing by registered person prior 2024 October 12<sup>th</sup>.

## **5. CANCELATION OF A REGISTRATION**

### **Registration cancellation insurance**

The purpose of this cancellation insurance is to allow the runners to be fully reimbursed of the registration fee if they wish to cancel their registration. The cancellation insurance is directly operated under the terms and conditions of registration platform NJUKO.

- Cost: 10% of the registration fee.
- Cancellation insurance must be taken out at the time of registration.
- If the runner does not subscribe to the insurance at registration process, no refund will be possible





### **Exceptional conditions:**

### **Cancellation of the Event:**

If a race is cancelled or if the event needs to be organized differently (e.g. one or more races need to be cancelled), for any reason beyond the control of Puerto Vallarta Mexico by UTMB, more than 60 days before the start, runners will be partially refunded the entry fees. The amount of the refund will be decided as to allow the organization to deal with the irremediable expenses incurred as of the date of the cancellation.

If a race is cancelled less than 60 days before the start or if a race in progress is interrupted fees will not be refunded.

### **UTMB World Series Pregnancy Policy**

In the ongoing effort of UTMB to increase and encourage women participation in trail running, UTMB has implemented a new pregnancy policy across all by UTMB events.

### Who is Eligible for Deferral?

- Athletes that are pregnant
- Athletes with a partner that is pregnant.
- Athletes that are adopting or birthing via surrogacy

### **Conditions for Deferral?**

The organizer will provide a full refund or a deferred entry to the same race (or a category below) valid for up to 2 years to runners meeting one of the conditions listed here under and able to present the proof.

- A woman whose pregnancy is known between the date of registration and the date of the race, when able to present the proof of the pregnancy.
- The partner of a woman who is pregnant, with a due date less than 3 months before, and no more than 3 months after, the race date. Partners are also required to present proof of relationship or residence with the women who is pregnant.
- Parents that can provide an adopting or birth certificate with an official date of less than 6 months before the race day.

Athletes should request the event organizer in writing: <u>ablanco@grupoochoa.com.mx</u> to use their priority or deferred entry for the year they plan to compete as early as possible. The deadline for requests is before the end of the race registration or pre-registration period for lottery events. For events that require a valid UTMB Index, athletes must ensure their index is valid at the time they choose to participate in the race.

This policy is not applicable if the pregnancy was known before registration. In the situation where the pregnancy is known after the athlete preregistered and before the lottery the athlete will be allowed to cancel her pre-registration and be refunded related fees.





If within the time of the deferral the runner is once again in the above-mentioned 'Conditions for deferral' the process can be repeated.

UTMB reserves the right to request additional verification of the relevant circumstances and may deny a deferral request if the documentation provided is deemed insufficient.
