



REGISTRATION CONDITIONS

1. ENTRY TERMS

Registrations (i.e. entries) for the 2024 edition of Ultra-Trail Snowdonia by UTMB:

Open at 10:00 on Wednesday 24 May 2023

Close at 23:59 on Friday 23 February 2024

Registrations may close before this date if the capacity for a competition is filled in advance. If a competition has reached capacity it will be marked as 'sold-out' on the event website.

There will not be a waiting list in operation for any of the race distances.

2024 entry capacities are as follows:

- UTS 100M approximately 300
- UTS 100K approximately 700
- UTS 50K approximately 1,200
- ERYRI 25K approximately 800

Entries will be made exclusively on the internet and payment will be made by credit card.

Registrations are not accepted on the day of the event. All registrations must be completed and paid before the date listed above.

Registrations are open to anyone over 20 years of age on the day of the race (ERYRI 25K is open to those aged 17+).

Prior to the event, all participants must have read and understood the [EVENT RULES](#) including the mandatory equipment needed to be carried at all times during their race.

2. REGISTRATION FEES

25% of entries to all distances will be available upon launch at a reduced 'early bird' fee. Entry fee prices will rise after the 'early bird' fee. Pricing is inventory-based according to quantities and will automatically increase when capacity at each price band has been filled.

- UTS 100M prices £229 – £289
- UTS 100K prices £179 – £209
- UTS 50K prices £129 – £159
- ERYRI 25K prices £79 – £99

During the registration process you will be offered the option to pay an additional fee for cancellation insurance (see section 5 for further information).

Registration fees include 20% VAT. All prices displayed on the registration platform are subject to an additional 8% card processing fee. This card processing fee is non-refundable in case of cancellation (including with cancellation insurance).

3. LOCAL RESIDENTS

A discount of 15% is available to local participants residing in the counties of Anglesey, Conwy or Gwynedd. To be eligible for this discount you need to provide proof of your home address. You must send one of the following to entries.uk@utmb.world:

- A copy of a utility bill showing your name and address (dated within the last three months).
- A copy of your valid driving licence photocard showing your name and address.

Please ensure your name and address are clearly visible. We cannot provide a discount if we do not have this information. The discount applies to the registration price only. The discount does not apply to any additional purchases or the cancellation insurance.

You must provide proof of your home address before completing your registration. We cannot issue discount codes to registrations which have already been completed and paid.

4. WHAT'S INCLUDED

Each registration fee includes the following* at Ultra-Trail Snowdonia by UTMB:

- 25 / 55 / 103 / 168km of pure, unbridled Ultra-Trail® running in rugged, Welsh mountain terrain.
- Stunning, waymarked and signed routes, with the most breath-taking views and vistas of northern Snowdonia (weather permitting!).
- 1 / 3 / 7 / 12 well-stocked and sheltered aid stations along each course.
- Drop bag facility at the half-way aid station for 100K and 100M runners.
- 1 / 2 / 3 / 4× UTMB® Running Stones respectively (finishers only) allowing entry to the UTMB® Mont-Blanc ballot – the UTMB® World Series Finals.
- Choice of technical or organic cotton event T-shirt for ultra-distance runners on the 50K, 100K or 100M (or plant a tree instead with Trees Not Tees).
- Genuine Buff® for ERYRI 25K runners.
- ~~Choice of beverage glass or~~ Distance-specific medal for all finishers.
- UTS car window and sticker pack.
- UTMB® World Series drawstring drop bag for 100K and 100M runners; reuseable at other World Series events.
- Waterproof and durable race route map for all ultra-distance runners.
- Live timing and results by [LiveTrail](#).
- Live GPS tracking by [Open Tracking](#) for 100K and 100M runners.
- Professional event photography and videography.
- Repatriation service for non-finishers from aid stations back to Llanberis.
- Warm meal (ultra-distance runners only) and local real ale (soft drink option available) for finishers.
- Start and finish at the stunning [National Slate Museum](#) with toilets, showers, food and drink vendors.
- Free entry to the [Ultra-Trail Village](#) (home of Registration, local and national brands) on Friday and Saturday.
- Trophies for top 5 male and female overall, and for 1st male and female age group finishers in each distance.
- Mountain Safety Team present throughout the routes.
- Emergency medical cover throughout the race and at the finish.
- The opportunity to finish the UK's only UTMB® World Series event!

5. CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

You are offered the option to subscribe to cancellation insurance during the entry process. If you intend to take out cancellation insurance, it must be purchased with your registration.

The purpose of cancellation insurance is to reimburse registration fees paid for the 2024 edition of Ultra-Trail Snowdonia by UTMB event when the insured runner is forced to withdraw due to certain conditions, which are detailed [HERE](#).

Runners who wish to subscribe to cancellation insurance will be asked to pay an additional 10% to their registration fee. Cancellation insurance must be booked exclusively at the time of registration. Cancellation of an entry, or non-participation in the competition, does not entitle the runner to a priority entry for a subsequent year or event.

There will be no refund for runners who wish to cancel their registration and do not have cancellation insurance.

Cancellation insurance, and general conditions of refund, are managed externally to UTMB. If you took out the cancellation insurance and would like to begin your claim, [CLICK HERE](#).

6. TRANSFER POLICY

It is possible to transfer your registration to another competition (i.e. race distance) at Ultra-Trail Snowdonia, or to transfer your registration to another person. See below for guidance.

Transfer to another competition in the same event

You can transfer from one competition to another competition until the registration closing date, providing there are registrations available in the new race distance. We cannot transfer your registration into a competition which has reached capacity and has sold-out.

If you wish to enter a longer race distance, you will be asked to pay the difference in registration fee. You will not be entered in the new competition until the fee has been paid.

If you wish to enter a shorter race distance, the difference in registration fee will not be refunded. If you want to change back to the longer race at a later date, you will be asked to pay the difference in registration fee. Therefore, please think carefully before requesting multiple transfers between race distances.

If you wish to transfer to another competition, use our [Contact Us](#) form selecting 'Registration transfer' and state which race distance you want to transfer to.

Transfer to another runner

You can transfer your registration to another person until the registration closing date. The new person will have to pay the current registration fee applicable at the date of transfer.

Once payment is received and their registration is confirmed; you will be refunded your registration fee minus (i) the card processing fee, (ii) the cancellation insurance fee (if applicable) and (iii) a £20.00 transfer fee.

To transfer your registration to another person, use the 'Transfer my registration' function within your MyUTMB account. Once you have completed the transfer, please use our [Contact Us](#) form to request your refund, clearly stating the name and e-mail address of the person who you have transferred your registration to.

You cannot transfer your registration to another person and ask for their registration to be transferred to a different competition at the same time. These are two separate requests.

7. EVENT CANCELLATION / FORCE MAJEURE

If a race is cancelled, or if the event needs to be organised differently (e.g. one or more races are cancelled), for any reason beyond the control of UTMB Group, more than 30 days before the start of the event, runners will be partially refunded the registration fees as listed below.

The amount of the refund will be decided as to allow UTMB Group to deal with the irreversible expenses incurred at the date of the cancellation.

Runners will be refunded as follows:

Date of cancellation	% Refund
Until 1 January 2024	60%
Until 1 March 2024	50%
Until 1 April 2024	30%
From 1 April 2024	No refund

If a race is cancelled less than 30 days before the start of the event, or if a race in progress is interrupted, for any reason beyond the control of UTMB UK, entry fees will not be refunded.

8. RIGHTS FOR IMAGES

By taking part in the event; each participant gives their consent for the organiser to use their image, either in photography or videography, for immediate and future use by the organiser and associated partners. Only the organisation can transfer this right for images to any media, via an accreditation or relevant license.

Ultra-Trail® and UTMB® are legally registered trademarks. All communication about the event or the use of images from the event must respect the name of the event, the registered trademarks and have official approval from the organisation.

9. ELITE ATHLETES

To give fair recognition to high-level athletes and to ensure a fair management of entry applications, we reserve places for elite athletes according to their UTMB Index (see [HERE](#)).

Elite athletes must contact the organiser using our [Contact Us](#) form and select 'Other' before registration closes. The minimum UTMB Index criteria considered for elite athletes **within each specific competition distance** are listed below. This is the UTMB Index the athlete must have on the day they contact the organiser to register **for the competition distance**.

The top three runners of a country may also benefit from a direct, paid entry, if they do not meet the pre-determined UTMB Index criteria listed in the table above. To be eligible, the athletes must be listed within the top three runners (either male or female) for their respective country on the UTMB Index on the day they contact the organiser to register.

Sponsored elite athletes should seek accommodation and travel support from their sponsor. The organiser does not provide accommodation and travel support to sponsored athletes.

10. MEDIA AND INFLUENCERS

Requests from media representatives, upcoming athletes and influential people with a strong social media following may be considered for either a direct paid entry, or a direct free entry, into competitions. This is at the discretion of UTMB UK and does not guarantee entry.

11. INDIVIDUAL SPONSORS

Participants who are sponsored can only display their sponsor's logos on their clothing and equipment during the race. All other sponsoring items — such as flags or banners — are forbidden along the race route including at the finishing line.

12. POLITICAL EXPRESSION

Any obtrusive or offensive political or social messaging or images displayed during the event, including on a participant's clothing or equipment, is prohibited. This may lead to disqualification from the event.
