UTMB World Series heads to Argentina for first of three South American Events

4,200 runners ready to discover the testing trails, cultural treasures, and epic scenery at Valhöll Argentina by UTMB



Dubbed 'the most epic race in Argentina', international runners also get the chance to experience the bucket-list destination via mountain trails, river crossings and beautiful peaks.

A Calamuchita native, Adriana Vanesa Vargas (ARG, UTMB Index 669) knows the trails more than most as she takes on the 'Epic 125K'. Seizing the opportunity to qualify for the UTMB World Series Finals in front of family and friends, she will face strong competition in the Women's race, including Annie Hughes (USA, UTMB Index 711) and Tara Fraga (USA, UTMB Index 743).

The Argentinian trails also caught the attention of UTMB Legend, Ludovic Pommeret (FRA, UTMB Index 872). The 2016 UTMB[®] and 2022 TDS[®] winner heads into the race as the top-ranked athlete, closely followed by Cristofer Clemente Mora (ESP, UTMB Index 863) who finished second at Valhöll Argentina by UTMB 100M in 2023.

Santos Gabriel Rueda (ARG, UTMB Index 825) will also be fighting for a podium position in front of a home crowd, commenting, "As someone originally from Argentina but now living in Europe, it is particularly special for me to have the opportunity to compete again in my home country and showcase my improvement since I left Argentina three years ago.

"It is truly exciting for both Argentina and the trail running community to host a UTMB World Series event and I am looking forward to the chance to compete alongside some of the world's top trail runners, as well as experiencing the unique atmosphere and breathtaking scenery that Argentina has to offer. It is going to be an unforgettable experience for everyone involved and I cannot wait to be part of it."

Sergio Gustavo Pereyra (ARG, UTMB Index 856) headlines the talented list of South American runners taking on the race. A bricklayer by trade, the Argentinian athlete finds innovative ways to combine work with training to prepare for upcoming races.

Favourites across the other race distances include Wellington Roberto Noronha (BRA, UTMB Index 828) and Remigio Huaman Quispe (PER, UTMB Index 836) in the 'ADVANCE 80K', Joaquin Narvaez (ARG, UTMB Index 835) and Nicolas Ignacio Benavides (CHI, UTMB Index 826) in the 'CHALLENGE 55K', Maria Paula Galindez (ARG, UTMB Index 651) and Ezequiel Alexis Pauluzak (ARG, UTMB Index 786) in the 'COURAGE 35K' and Tiago Vieira (POR, UTMB Index 847) in the 'POWER 22K'

A thrilling double-header weekend awaits for the UTMB World Series, as runners on the other side of the world prepare to tackle Ultra-Trail Snowdonia by UTMB in the United Kingdom.
