Race Results: Amazean Jungle Thailand by UTMB

Gediminas Grinius (BETONG 140 first place male):

"Tired..tired and shattered, but I am happy. Last year I won BETONG 100, but this time I wanted to try BETONG 140. These are two totally different races because of the weather. You can't even compare them. Today the first fifty kilometres we couldn't run, we had to be very cautious because of the mud conditions and wet leaves due to the rain. My legs were destroyed. It was out of this world. I've never done such a tough race. From the start I didn't try to follow Sangé who was leading the race at the beginning and just ran my race. After around forty kilometres I moved into the lead and after the first fifty kilometres the race became much more runnable and I managed to increase my distance from Sangé."

Francesca Canepa (BETONG 140 second place female):

"I feel sick and exhausted. The BETONG 140 was the hardest race I have ever done in my whole life. All parts of the race were so difficult. Also I am not used to the heat so I had to slow down. I was just committed to finishing the race in order to honor the organisation, the race itself and all the people involved. But it was so difficult for me, I even had to ask for medical assistance. It's always a challenge when you go so far away from home, you never know what conditions you can find yourself in. So I am actually very proud of finishing in second place and not giving up."
