

Dylan Bowman (USA, UTMB Index 856) will make the trip over to Europe to experience some of the mozart magic in the 105 km race. As one of the pre-race favourites, he will be looking to add some of his own magic to the trails, alongside Maite Maiora Elizondo (ESP, UTMB Index 756) in the Women Elite race.

mozart Ultra A close battle is expected in the 81 km race, with Cristina Santurino (ESP, UTMB Index 695) and Julia Davis (GBR, UTMB Index 686) both looking for their first UTMB


World Series wins. mozart Marathon

Setting off from the stunning lakeside town of St Gilgen, the mozart Marathon looks to be a favourite amongst elite and amateur runners. In the Men Elite race, Tiago Vieira (POR, UTMB Index 846) will have to hold off the charging Italians, Hannes Perkmann (ITA, UTMB Index 840) and Giacomo Forconi (ITA, UTMB Index 855) in the hunt for the top spot. Sophia Laukli (USA, UTMB Index 790) looks to be the one to beat in the Women Elite race, but Martina Cumerlato (ITA, UTMB Index 710) and Katarina Lovrantova (SLO, UTMB Index 700) could be amongst the runners putting on the pressure from behind.

Race Directors, Claudia Kolussi and Josef Mayerhofer said, "With each passing year, mozart 100 by UTMB continues to exceed expectations, showcasing the very best of Salzburg's breathtaking landscapes and the spirit of endurance. As part of the esteemed UTMB World Series, this year's event promises unparalleled challenges and rewards for participants. Record-breaking numbers at Trail du Saint-Jacques by UTMB

on a cultural and spiritual journey around the stunning Haute-Loire region in France and the famous Camino de Santiago trails on 14-16 June, as part of Trail du Saint-Jacques by UTMB®.

A favourite amongst locals, with 91% of registered participants coming from France, the event uncovers the rural beauty, wild landscapes and imposing Massif Central Mountain Range as runners make their way towards the UNESCO World Heritage site of Cathédrale Notre-Dame du Puy-en-Velay and the new finish line for 2024 in front of the Rocher et Chapelle Saint-Michel d'Aiguilhe.



Trail du Saint-Jacques by UTMB[®] 50K runner-up, Laure Paradan (FRA, UTMB Index 713) will make the leap to the queen-100M stage for 2024. As her first 100-miler, Paradan is stepping into the unknown but already has experience on these trails and heads into the race as the top-ranked in the Women Elite race.


Paradan said, "I am an athlete but I work full time and it's sometimes hard to bulk up the distance in between. I wanted to run my first ultra on terrain that seemed quite familiar to me. I live in Puy-de-Dome, so the Saint-Jacques trail seemed like a good option to me, and I ran the 40km last year and really enjoyed the course. I think the terrain suits me quite well too!

"My main objective is to finish the race because it will be a new adventure for me, including starting the race in the night. I hope I manage the distance well and set a good time."

A strong French contingent also features in the Men Elite race, with Romain Lieux (FRA, UTMB Index 836), Alexandre Beraud (FRA, UTMB Index 834) and Samir Tazi (FRA, UTMB Index 820) amongst the favourites. Three-time French national trail champion, Thomas Cardin (FRA, UTMB Index 905)

will take on a UTMB World Series event for the first time and looks to be the one to beat in the Men Elite 100K. Anna Louise Astad Sørlie (NOR, UTMB Index 629) takes on one of her first international trail races in the Women Elite 50K, but should not be counted out for a top spot amongst some strong French athletes. The 2023 World Mountain and Trail Running Long trail (85km race) Champion,

Benjamin Roubiol (FRA, UTMB Index 897) joins Adeline Martin (FRA, UTMB Index 751) as the top-ranked athletes in their respective categories. Both take on a UTMB World Series event for the first time in 2024 and could be quick to make their mark. Two-time Ultra-Trail Snowdonia by UTMB® 50K podium finisher, Kirsteen Welch (GBR, UTMB Index 698) could prove dangerous on these trails however as she makes her comeback to racing after illness in 2023.
