Big reputation, big names and big elevation at UTMB World Series events in the United States of America

Course record holder headlines 51st edition of Western States 100 Endurance Run



369 participants will take to the start line at the Olympic Valley, California, near the site of the 1960 Winter Olympics. Amongst the line-up includes ten-time finishers, a growing number of women, 30 Golden Ticket winners plus current course record holder and the 2024 UTMB® winner at HOKA UTMB® Mont-Blanc, Jim Walmsley (USA, UTMB Index 934).



Women Elite One of the UTMB Legends, Katie Schide (USA, UTMB Index 825) will be looking to improve on her second place from 2023 and will join a star-studded Women Elite field including third-placed Eszter Csillag (HUN, UTMB Index 768) and three-time finisher Emily Hawgood (ZWE, UTMB Index 757). The firsttimers should not be counted out either, especially with names like Emily Schmitz (USA, UTMB Index 736), Eleanor Davis (GBR, UTMB Index 753) and Heather Jackson (USA, UTMB Index 764) amongst the line-up.

Men Elite In the Men Elite field, two-time winner Jim Walmsley will be looking to retain his title and perhaps even make a dent in his own course record which stands from 2019 at 14:09:28. He will face a talent of experienced opposition, including 2023 runner-up and four-time finisher, Tyler Green (USA, UTMB Index 880) and several other top finishers from 2023, including **Jiasheg Shen** (CHN, UTMB Index 906). Dakota Jones (USA, UTMB Index 902), Ji Duo (CHN, UTMB Index 889) and **Hayden Hawks** (USA, UTMB Index 910) accepted their Golden Ticket offers alongside Walmsley and will also be hoping to battle it out at the front of the race in Northern California.

The event also **celebrates the return of two 15-time finishers**, Dan Barger and Charley Jones, alongside 1,000 mile-buckle holder - an award that goes to runners who have completed the event ten-times and all under 24 hours - Luanne Park who hopes to add another finish to her name.





The stunning Snowbird Ski Resort in the Wasatch Mountains, Utah will welcome 1,500 runners to one of the toughest endurance races in the United States of America on July 19-20 at Speedgoat™ Mountain Races by UTMB[®], with an increased number of local runners taking to their home trails for this edition of the race.

the flagship 50K race covering 11,800ft of climbing via Snowbird, Baldy and Hidden Peak, it promises to be a tough but rewarding challenge. Two 20K races, plus a shorter 10km distance opens the event to participants of all levels as they experience the best of the mountain trails, rocky terrain, breathtaking views and vibrant wildlife.

Speedgoat Mountain Races by UTMB Race Director, Karl Meltzer said, "The 50K is intimidating and isn't the best option for a first-timer. In the 28km race, they still have the first climb through to the top at 4,500 feet, and still go through the Snowbird tunnel and get the 'intimidation factor' with the last climb. So, they still get a taste of what the 50K is like, although the backside of the moment is equally as

hard." **Women Elite**

An unforgettable day of racing is predicted in the Women Elite race, with runners such as Jazmine Lowther (CAN, UTMB Index 767), Martina Valmossi (ITA, UTMB Index 765) and EmKay Sullivan (USA, UTMB Index 765) amongst an impressive list of runners ready to test the limits in the Wasatch Mountains.

Men Elite

In the Men's race, it looks set to be equally as exciting! Adam Peterman (USA, UTMB Index 930), Eli Hemming (USA, UTMB Index 911) and Chad Hall (USA, UTMB Index 898) head into the race as the top-ranked but it will be all to play for as anything can happen over the notoriously challenging course at Speedgoat Mountain Races by UTMB.
