

## Ecuador's bustling capital promises unforgettable first edition at Quito Trail by UTMB



As the capital of Ecuador and a UNESCO World Heritage Centre, Quito promises an unforgettable atmosphere as over 2,600 runners discover the Andes mountains, Chirinchos waterfall and Pichincha Volcano via forest trails and farm roads.

With over 80% of participants deriving from Ecuador, locals have seized the opportunity to be part of an unforgettable first edition, discover the best of their country and go head-to-head with international competition, all while collecting Running Stones to go towards the 2025 UTMB® World Series Finals lottery.

Joaquin Lopez (ECU, UTMB Index 862) enters the race as the home favourite and local hero. Having already secured a UTMB World Series podium earlier this year at Trail 100 Andorra™ by UTMB® (100M), Lopez looks to be the man to beat to the finish line in Quito.

He said, "It is a dream come true to have a UTMB World Series race come to

Ecuador. Since I started running 12 years ago, my dream was to compete at the

famous UTMB World Series Finals. After I accomplished that dream in 2019, I dreamt that people in my country could live the same life changing experience that I had. Quito Trail by UTMB will be the first chance for many Ecuadoreans and South Americans to be part of a world class event, and have a more tangible path collecting Running Stones towards reaching one day the UTMB World Series Finals." "Ecuador is a natural playground of outdoor sports. Having the opportunity to have a point-to-point race, starting in deep cloud forest where you can see beautiful

wildlife such as the spectacled bear or toucans, and then in a matter of hours find yourself 3,400m above sea level near the summit of Pichincha Volcano, then to drop drastically to the historic centre of Quito is just something I don't think you can find anywhere else in the world. Honestly, runners can expect a real adventure and a wild experience that combines everything you want for a race" Other top athletes looking to make their mark at a new South American event include

Valhöll Argentina by UTMB® 100K winner, Remigio Huaman Quispe (PER, UTMB Index 828), four-time UTMB World Series podium finisher, Fernanda Maciel (BRA, UTMB Index 585) in the women's race, plus international competitor and multiple world-record holder, **Tyler Andrews** (USA, UTMB Index 753). Fernanda Maciel said, "The race looks wild and it is in high altitude. I have taken

part in the UTMB Finals nine times, but I really want to run in a new environment, discover different mountains and be beside runners from Latin America. I am super excited to race in Ecuador! Having more events like this in Latin America will set good standards and I am happy to see our sport growing here."

With five race distances on offer, from 8 km to 78 km, the event promises an incredible atmosphere and celebration as the local community and trail running community come together in the vibrant and cultural city.



#### Jungle mountains meet charming coastal town at **Paraty Brazil by UTMB**



Paraty Brazil by UTMB<sup>®</sup> returns for its second edition on September 19-22, ready to welcome 3,000 runners to its charming and historic town on Brazil's southeastern coast.

The event once again proves to be a favourite amongst locals, with 85% of runners coming from Brazil, ready to enjoy the best of the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Serra da Bocaina National Park and its native Atlantic Forest via one of the four race distances



on offer. Goosebumps, adrenaline and pure excitement will be high as runners head out via the cobbled streets, historic buildings and scenic beaches of Paraty. The challenge steps up, as 100K and 50K runners tick off the highest ascent of the race at Pedra da Macela (1,840m) before descending via the technical Trilha do Ouro - a trail used by the Portuguese during the mining period to transport gold from the interior of Brazil to Portugal.

One of the local legends taking on the race is Rogerio Silvestrin (BRA, UTMB Index 856), defending champion in the 100K race.

The who's who of top-ranked Brazilian runners continues, including Wellington Roberto Noronha (UTMB Index 828), Celio Augusto Rosa (UTMB Index 824), Leticia Saltori (UTMB Index 696) and Fernanda Maciel who is also taking on Quito Trail by UTMB in August.

She said, "This race is special for me for many reasons. Running in the Atlantic Forest is magical and I am passionate about its formation, its different shades of green and types of trails within the forest. For me, it feels like going back to my childhood and running without ever wanting to stop."

24-year-old Ayslan Miragaia (BRA, UTMB Index 773) is also back for more, having won the 20K race in 2023 and proving himself amongst international competition. Taking on his debut 50K race for this edition, he said, "I hope to have a good race with a calm mindset, as it will be my first time running 55km. I am planning a solid race strategy to perform well during the event and it is my dream to win, especially as it is an incredible event that attracts many people from many countries.
