



HOKA UTMB Mont-Blanc 2025: August 25-31

The HOKA UTMB Mont-Blanc, featuring its three iconic finals - the OCC (50K), the CCC (100K), and the UTMB (100M) - will take place from August 25 to 31 in the Mont-Blanc region.

The participant lottery draw for the 2025 finals was held on January 16, giving each runner a chance to write their own history. From the UTMB World Series Finals to renowned races like the TDS, MCC, ETC, YCC and the legendary PTL, the week promises to be a celebration of trail running. Legendary athletes, rising stars, and trail enthusiasts - whether runners, supporters or spectators - will gather in the Mont-Blanc region spanning France, Italy and Switzerland for a joyous week of shared sporting passion and adventure.

Get as close to the action on the trails as possible: A UTMB World Series promise

Throughout the 2025 season, trail running enthusiasts, friends, families and supporters will be able to follow all the action remotely, thanks to two innovative systems:

the race management, tracking, and timing system implemented across all UTMB World Series events.

These include Wildstrubel by UTMB[®], Nice Côte d'Azur by UTMB[®], Trail Verbier St-Bernard by UTMB[®], the four Majors, and the circuit finals: the OCC (50K), CCC (100K) and UTMB (100M) during HOKA UTMB Mont-Blanc. The **first live broadcast** of the season will feature **Tenerife Bluetrail by UTMB**® on March 29.

The full **UTMB Live 2025** schedule, listing all the events with live coverage, will be announced in the coming weeks.

Sustainable and inclusive trail running is a core commitment of the UTMB World Series

UTMB® World Series again reaffirms its collective commitment to building a sustainable future for trail running. The circuit aims to make the sport **more inclusive and accessible**, respecting the environment while delivering authentic experiences deeply rooted in local communities. The UTMB World Series continues to **strengthen its social and environmental actions** to reduce the ecological footprint of its events and **promote diversity** among participants. This effort includes new initiatives integrated in the Arc of Attrition by UTMB®, which will kick off the season with reinforced measures to encourage women's participation, such as She Races recommendations, and a live Q&A session to connect with and hear from women interested in trail running.
