



After delivering 165+ hours of live coverage and amassing 16 million views across 8 events (and 22 races) in 2024, UTMB® Live is set to expand further in 2025. This season 12 events will be streamed live, including four new additions. Broadcasts will be available in 7 languages -French, English, Spanish, Chinese, German, Italian and Thai - depending on the host region.

Season kick-off: Chianti Ultra Trail by UTMB

The 2025 season launches with the live broadcast of the Chianti Ultra Trail by UTMB, featuring a world-class elite field, chasing the 4 HOKA Golden Tickets to access the Western States ® 100-Mile Endurance Run. In the 100M, the three last UTMB champions — Kilian Jornet, Jim Walmsley and Vincent Bouillard - are set for a thrilling showdown. Meanwhile, the women's elite race will also see top contenders on the start line: Azara Garcia De Los Salmones, Abby Hall and Fiona Pascall.
