POTENTIAL NEXT STEP

Take inventory of the music you listen to and the shows you watch. Make a conscious effort to reduce the world's influences and increase the kingdom's influences in your life. Note the difference it makes to your mindset and mood when you have a kingdom focus!

MAIN POINTS & SCRIPTURES

- We live in an ungodly world not unlike a lion's den. The world is winding down, but the kingdom of God is winding up. (Romans 6:16; Matthew 24:12-14; Luke 16:16)
- 2. The people of God are called to influence *nations*, not just individuals. (Genesis 1:28; Matthew 28:18-19) All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Jesus. Satan has no authority he can roar but he cannot bite. (Matthew 16:18-19; 1 John 4:4)

Here are four things the world wants to do to us, and our responses:

- 3. Change our thinking. (Daniel 1:1-4) The world wants us to think like them (evolution, movies, media, music, etc). Our response is to meditate on the Word of God. (Romans 12:2; Matthew 16:23; Psalm 119:11)
- Change our tastes. (Daniel 1:5a) The world wants to give us a taste for sin, but we have a taste for the presence of God. (Hebrews 11:25; James 1:13-15; Psalm 34:8; Psalm 23:5) Our response is to feast on the bread of life and drink from the spring of living water. (John 6:35)
- 5. <u>Train us in the ways of darkness</u>. (Daniel 1:5b) The world wants to move us from the law of God to the rules of man. *Our response is to embrace our spiritual training*. (Isaiah 55:9; 1 Timothy 4:7; Psalm 25:4) Church is not an optional experience; it's a necessary gathering to equip our hearts and hands.
- 6. Change our identity. (Daniel 1:6-7) When we lose our identity, we lose our purpose. Our response is to, by faith, believe we are who He says we are, regardless of how we feel. (1 Peter 2:9) In Jesus, we are the righteousness of God His beloved sons/daughters.
- 7. There are four common responses when the world tries to conform us:
 - a. Ostrich bury our heads in the sand; pretend it's not happening
 - **b.** Road Runner run fast; outrun the brokenness; fill up our lives
 - c. Rooster obnoxiously strut; argue; crow; criticize
 - d. Eagle (Isaiah 40:31) take on God's kingdom perspective
- 8. God's ways work. When we live out God's ways, the world will see His goodness and want to know our secret. (Daniel 1:15-20; 2 Corinthians 4:8-10)
