

BIG IDEA: The giants in your life are big, but Jesus is bigger.

SUMMARY

Learning to live a lifestyle of going to new places with God can help us conquer the giants of this world. Our future is on the other side of the giants we don't want to face. It's time to take hold of these lessons to experience victory over our giants in Jesus' name.

KEY POINTS

LESSON #7: CHANGE YOUR THINKING—CHANGE YOUR LIVING

"Your giants are not the people in your life." (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

"We have to *remove, release, and replace* our thoughts with the truth of the finished work of Jesus."

"Stop waiting for Jesus to do what He's already told us to do." (Romans 12:2)

"Whatever shapes your thoughts shapes your life." (Psalm 19:14)

"Ask yourself, 'Do my thoughts glorify God and align with the finished work of Jesus?'"

"Stop feeding your giant and start defeating your giant in Jesus' name."

What thoughts do you need to remove, release, and replace with the truth of the finished work of Jesus?

LESSON #8: HANG OUT WITH GIANT KILLERS

"Do you gather around people who are victims of their giants or victorious over their giants?" (1 Samuel 22:2)

"Hang out with people who are defeating their own giants." (Numbers 11:28)

"Whoever we hang out with we become like." (Proverbs 13:20)

"You will tolerate your giants until you are desperate enough to deal with them."

Who do you gather around when you have a giant in your life?

LESSON #9: GET UP AGAIN

"You may have lost the battle, but Jesus has already won the war."

"The righteous refuse to allow a temporary loss to become a permanent defeat." (Proverbs 24:16)

"God's grace is enough." (2 Corinthians 12:9-10)

"In the midst of a giant that hasn't fallen yet we can still move forward." (Psalm 23:5-6)

Where in your life do you need to keep getting up again?

BONUS LESSON: DEAL WITH YOUR GIANTS SO THE NEXT GENERATION DOESN'T HAVE TO

"Your kids don't need more stuff; they need less giants."

"Facing giants costs you something now but it could cost them everything later."

"Don't give your kids the battle God has called you to win."

"Either you increase and advance or your giants increase and advance."

"There are some battles you should have never had to fight but we get to be the people to say, they didn't but we will."

"This isn't just about your physical children, this is about all of us reproducing the life of God in this world so others can go further and farther than we ever have."

What giant has God called you to defeat so your future generations don't have to? Is there a giant you're facing that wasn't defeated by an earlier generation?

TAKEAWAY:

Spend time with Jesus this week applying these lessons in the areas God has revealed a giant in your life. Remember, Jesus is bigger than your giants.
